

To qualify for the Provisional Early Childhood endorsement, applicants must hold a valid Arizona Elementary or Special Education teaching certificate and pass the Arizona Educator Proficiency Assessment (AEPA) Subject Knowledge Early Childhood (* AZO36) exam.
