This school year, 2014-2015, TUSD launched a Spanish/English Two-Way Dual Language (TWDL) Immersion Model and was designated as an Advanced Learning Experience (ALE) that nurtures early development of bilingual or multilingual children who excel academically across subjects, interact effectively with people from different cultures and compete successfully in the global market. The implementation of the model began this school year in grades K-2, 6th, and 9th in ten participating schools with other grade levels implementing this model over the next few years.
