Dropout Specialists

The District staffed five targeted middle schools with part time dropout prevention specialists (Valencia, Doolen, Naylor, Safford, and Secrist) to work with middle school students demonstrating at-risk indicators. Districtwide, Student Services made available online the "Student Equity and Intervention Request for Service" submission form. Sites used the form to request additional services or support for at-risk students on their campuses. Student Services provided 152 interventions for at-risk students as a result of online submissions for middle school sites. Dropout prevention specialists provided "Step by Step" presentations to all middle school/K-8 campuses for all 8th graders to prepare them for the transition to high school, expectations, and information on the credit tracking process towards graduation.
