This letter describes the major changes to the budget based on the collaboration between the Parties and Special Master over the past three months, additional information to assist the Parties, Special Master, and Budget Operations Expert in understanding the revised budget, and the District's responses to the final recommendations discussed on August 8, 2014, and transmits the TUSD budget adopted by the district's Governing Board August 12, 2014 as well as a supplemental USP Budget Criteria Worksheet.

Consistent with the communication from Bill Brammer, the District agrees that the Parties' tenday objection period should begin on August 15, 2014. If there are additional questions and/or objections, please provide them in writing. If agreeable, the District recommends that the Parties and Special Master participate in another teleconference to clarify questions and discuss issues rather than relying on email communications.

## I. CHANGES BETWEEN THE JUNE 2, 2014 PROPOSED USP BUDGET AND THE AUGUST 12, 2014 FINAL USP BUDGET

On May 16, 2014, the District submitted a draft proposed budget, but the Plaintiffs requested a reformatted version. On June 2, 2014, the District submitted a Proposed USP Budget for 2014-15 to the Special Master and Parties. Between May and August 2014, the District continued to work collaboratively with the Special Master and Plaintiffs through an ongoing exchange of comments, feedback and responses and through two teleconferences devoted solely to collaboration on developing the budget. After reviewing, analyzing, and incorporating comments and feedback from the Special Master and Plaintiffs, the District has revised the budget to include more accurate benefits and salary information<sup>1</sup>, and to incorporate changes to allow the District to implement the USP more efficiently and effectively in a manner that is aligned to the

District's overall reorganization<sup>2</sup>. The list below describes all major changes to the final USP Budget (new items include references to the attached supplemental budget criteria worksheet):

#### **Benefits** [All Projects]

As of June 2, 2014, the District had yet to calculate the new benefit rates that would affect salaries across the board, including changes required by the Affordable Care Act. The District used the 2013-14 benefit rates to create the Proposed USP Budget that was submitted on June 2, 2014. The adjustment of benefits accounts for the greatest adjustment of funds overall between the proposed and final budgets.

#### **Salaries** [All Projects]

As of June 2, 2014, the District used average salaries (based on the average salaries from 2013-14) to create the Proposed USP Budget that was submitted on June 2, 2014. The revised budget includes a teacher salary adjustment resulting from the Districtwide initiative to address teacher salary compression<sup>3</sup>. Since June 2014, the District has corrected the salary figures to accurately reflect the appropriate teacher average salary.

### Overhead [Project 11]

As a response to comments and feedback from the Special Master, the Mendoza Plaintiffs, and the Fisher Plaintiffs, the District eliminated the budget lines for overhead and direct billed costs allocable to specific USP activities that had received 910(g) funding in the past. These include: a portion of AP teacher salaries, a portion of dual-language teacher salaries; funding CRC teachers, and funding capital items to support ELL students.

### **Communications / AAAATF Recommendations** [Projects 2, 5, and 8]

As a response to comments and feedback from the Mendoza Plaintiffs (requesting more funding be allocated towards family engagement) and Fisher Plaintiffs (requesting more funding be allocated towards the African American Academic Achievement Task Force [AAAATF] recommendations), the District reallocated funds from the Communications Department (Project 2) to Family Engagement (Project 8) and towards implementation of the AAAATF Recommendations (Project 5).

<u>Facilities / UHS Portable Classrooms</u> [Project 11] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

As a response to the Court Order of June 25, 2014 approving the District's Notice and Request for Approval and permitting the District to relocate portable classrooms to UHS, the District has allocated \$400,000 to Project 11 to complete their relocation to UHS.

#### **Assistant Superintendents** [Projects 5 and 6]

In response to comments and feedback from the Special Master, the District removed 910(g) funding from the Assistant Superintendent for Elementary and K8 Schools, Secondary Schools, and Curriculum and Instruction (including their support staff).

# <u>Sr. Director of Desegregation Compliance and Equity</u> [Project 5] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

To implement the USP in a more efficient and effective manner, the District created an Assistant Superintendent for Student Support Services who supervises a Senior Director for Desegregation Compliance and Equity, who in turn supervises the Director of Desegregation, the Family Engagement Director, and the four student services directors. This change is budget neutral as it merely renames and repurposes the position that had been titled "Executive Director for E&I" in the June 2, 2014 Proposed USP Budget.

#### Family Engagement Director (.5 Deseg / .5 Title I)

**Community Outreach Coordinator (.5 Deseg / .5 Title I)** 

<u>Family Engagement Coordinator (.5 Deseg / .5 Title I)</u> [Project 8] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

In response to comments and feedback from the Special Master and Mendoza Plaintiffs, the District hereby describes in detail how it has reallocated resources to support family engagement. Under the reorganization, and to demonstrate our commitment to student success through family and community engagement, the District created a structure to implement districtwide family engagement strategies for all students and families, with a special focus on struggling students. This structure includes a Senior Director for Desegregation Compliance and Equity that supervises a Family Engagement Director, who in turn works closely with the four student services directors, Title I, and other related departments and directly with schools. In the June 2, 2014 Proposed USP Budget, a .5 FTE (\$30,000) for "Community Outreach Coordinator" was allocated to Project 2; this position has been transferred to Project 8 (see above description of change to Communications). The total 1.0 FTE for the other two positions (approximately \$98,000 with benefits) is being reallocated from the original \$500,000 amount allocated to implement the Family and Community Engagement Plan.

# <u>Sr. Director of Curriculum Development (.25 Deseg / .75 M&O)</u> [Project 6] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

To implement the USP in a more efficient and effective manner, and in response to the Curriculum and Efficiency Audits, the District created this position to oversee curriculum development, including directly supervising the Director of Culturally Relevant Pedagogy and Instruction and the Director of Multicultural Curriculum, and will ensure that the District is meeting the implementation timelines and goals associated with these programs in a manner that is consistent with the overall curriculum development in the District.

# <u>Sr. Director of Curriculum Deployment (.25 Deseg / .75 M&O)</u> [Project 6] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

This person will ensure compliance with all USP professional development activities and supervise the Learning Support Coordinators at each site. A primary function will be to ensure that the Multi Tiered System of Support (MTSS) is being implemented with fidelity. This funding draws on the funding available from removing the previous function titled "Director of Professional Development" in Project 12 (.8 FTE). This is the USP-required "director-level employee to coordinate professional development and support efforts" (USP Section IV.B.3).

# Sr. Director of Curriculum Assessment and Evaluation (.5 Deseg / .5 M&O) [Project 13] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

This person will ensure that data systems are in place to track performance data at sites, will develop metrics for the program evaluation of key aspects of the Unitary Status Plan, and will be integral to the development of the Evidence-Based Accountability System (EBAS).

### <u>Transition Counselors</u> [Project 11] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement)

In accordance with the Court's Order of February 15, 2013 approving school closures, and requiring the District to "allocate extra financial resources for support services for incoming and current students enrolled in D or C- receiving schools to mitigate the negative effects of the transition," additional school counselor services were needed at receiving schools. In the June 2, 2014 budget this item was not included as this issue was not identified and addressed until after June 2. This item would continue the funding from SY 2013-14.

It now has become evident that one year of counselor services is not sufficient to address the students' greater than expected social, emotional, academic and personal issues that arose as a result of merging schools. The counselors need to transition two cohorts of students on to high school to complete the assimilation process. Also, merging the schools created larger numbers of students in each grade level, but not enough to warrant an additional counselor FTE under the staffing formula. All three receiving schools have enrollments that fund one counselor by formula (1:500) and are close to numbers to fund two. Doolen (904), Mansfeld (801) and Secrist (670) were all receiving schools in SY 2013-14 (receiving students from Townsend, Wakefield,

and Carson, respectively). With the additional enrollment numbers and the compounded issues resulting from merging these middle schools, there is substantial need to continue this funding.

Research Project Managers [Project 11] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement) The 2013-14 budget included funding equal to these three positions. However, one position was funded directly in Project 13, and funding equal to two positions was funded through overhead and allocated to A&R. Per requests from the Parties to fund 910(g) directly rather than through overhead, the District is funding these three positions directly in the final budget.

<u>Grow Our Own Program</u> [Project 12] (see attached Budget Criteria Worksheet Supplement) Per the USP, and as described in the Aspiring Leaders Plan, the District has collaborated with the University of Arizona to develop and implement this program to provide financial support to encourage identified employees to receive the required certifications and educational degrees needed for promotions.

The District, through this summary of changes, seeks to be fully transparent about revisions to the final USP budget. However, the District's budgeting system is still a manual process and therefore is subject to human error. If any major change is identified by any party that is not included in this description the District encourages the Special Master and/or the Parties to communicate their concerns to the District and the District will respond accordingly in its continued efforts at full transparency.

### II. DISTRICT RESPONSE TO FINAL RECOMMENDATIONS FROM THE SPECIAL MASTER AND THE PARTIES

Based on an August 8, 2014 teleconference among the Special Master and Parties, the District identified ten recommendations. The District agrees to all recommendations except for number six, and agrees to provide all requested justifications or explanations. Regarding recommendation number six, to eliminate LSCs, the USP provides that two years after adoption of the USP any party may request the discontinuation of an activity or expenditure that is "redundant, unnecessary, or unduly wasteful...." The District agrees with the Special Master's recommendation to conduct a program evaluation in 2014-15 to determine the efficacy of LSCs.

**Recommendation 1 (SM/Mendozas) Professional Development [PD]** [SM] Provide a \$2M "placeholder" or justify/explain how the funding for the 33 USP-required PD was determined; [Mendozas] Explain how funding is flowing to the USP PD requirements.

The District will provide an explanation as to how the funding for PD was determined.

**Recommendation 2 (SM/Mendozas): Psychologists** Describe how the District applied the funding formula to the funding allocation for Psychologists and explain how the allocation is supplementing and not supplanting.

**Recommendation 3 (SM): CRC Teachers** Describe how the District applied the funding formula to the funding allocation for CRC Teachers and explain how the allocation is supplementing and not supplanting.

**Recommendation 4 (SM/Mendozas): Dual-Language Teachers** Describe how the District applied the funding formula to the funding allocation for Dual-Language Teachers and explain how the allocation is supplementing and not supplanting.

**Recommendation 5 (SM/Mendozas) Portables at UHS** [SM] Justify the use of 910(g) funds to pay for portables at UHS; needs to be specifically linked; [Mendozas] Eliminate funding to move portables to UHS to make room for additional students.

The District is accepting the Special Master's recommendation and will provide a justification for the use of 910(g) funds to pay for portables at UHS.

**Recommendation 6 (Fishers) Learning Supports Coordinators (LSCs)** Eliminate LSCs from this year's budget.

Recommendation 7 (Fishers) African American Student Services Dep't (AASSD) Keep AASSD separate with a separate budget.

Recommendation 8 (Fishers) Set-Aside for AfAm/Latino Students in ES and MS Provide a set-aside to fund activities to support increased academic achievement of African American and Latino elementary and middle school students

**Recommendation 9 (Mendozas) CRC Courses** Provide funding to supplement CRC courses that have less than 27 students.

**Recommendation 10 (Mendozas) Fine Arts** Provide funding only for the portion of Fine Arts that is directly related to the USP.
