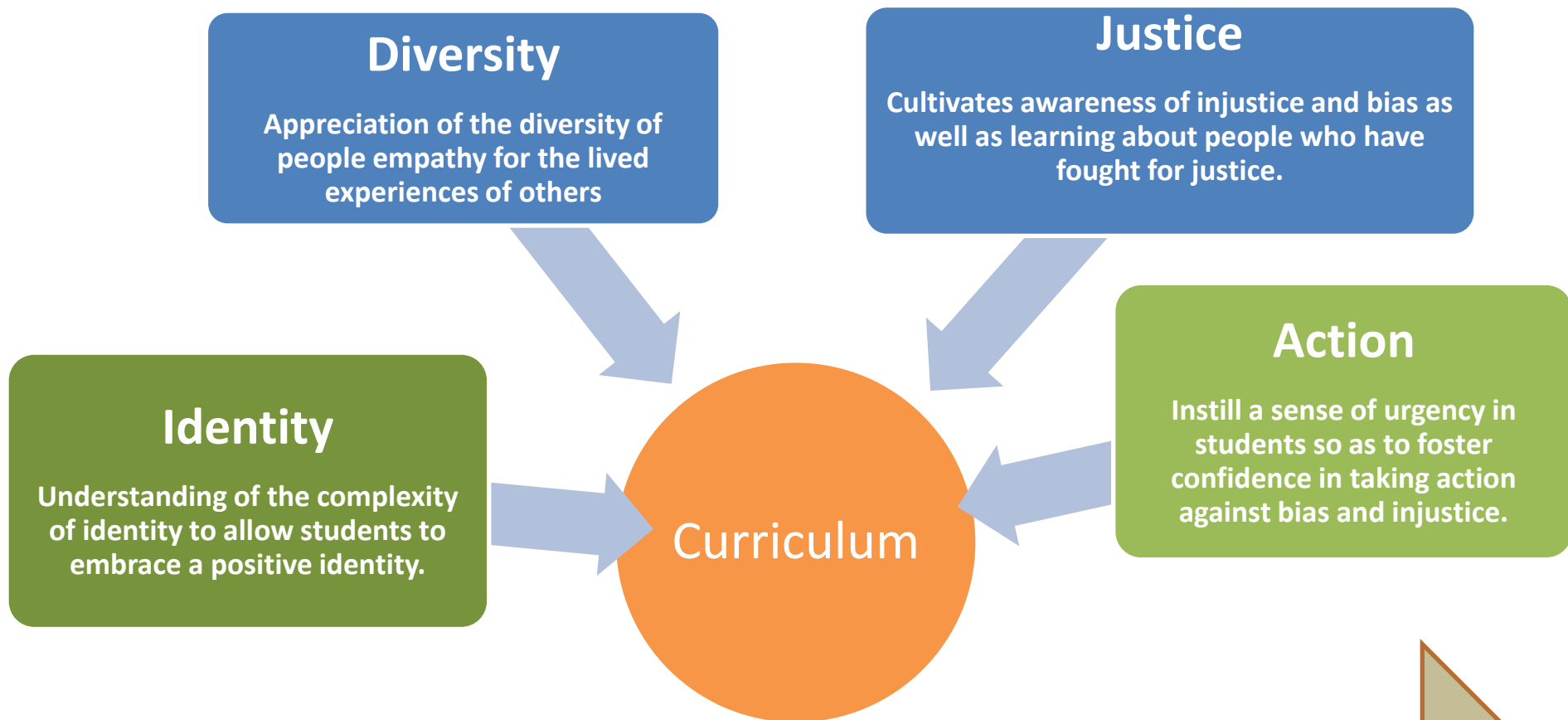

TUSD K-12 MULTICULTURAL CURRICULUM

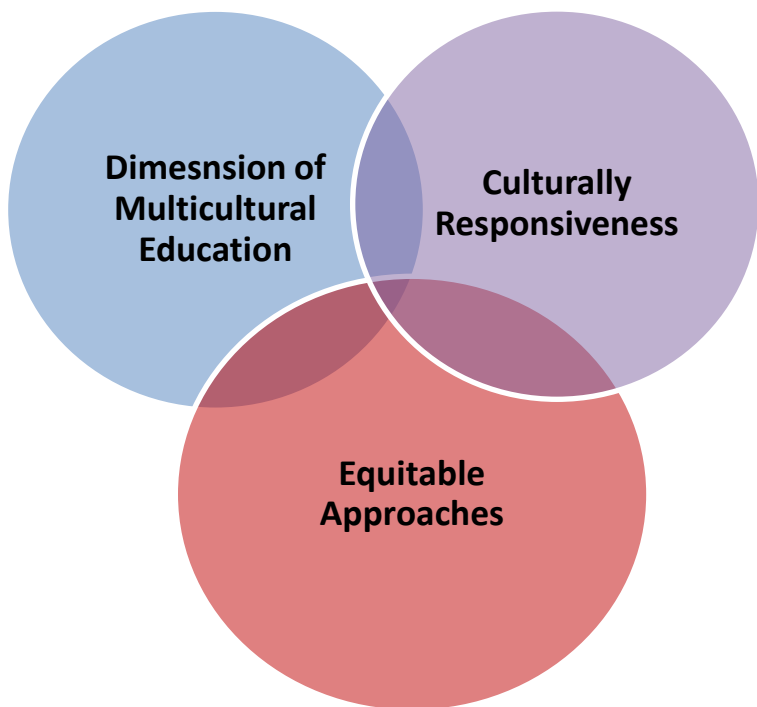
This framework is centered on inclusive education that builds on the district's diversity and is articulated in K-12 classrooms through TUSD 4.0 multicultural content.
