2. U.S Postal Services mailings to notify parents/guardians of magnet school lottery selection are time-sensitive. **Parents/guardians are responsible for notifying the school office to update a change of address in their student's record.**
3. Magnet schools/programs are subject to modification. Parent/guardian will be informed immediately if such modification affects the choice of schools/magnet programs.
4. Parents of out-of-district students and in-district open enrollment students must provide transportation. In-District magnet students may get free Magnet Transportation; qualified open enrollment students may get free Incentive Transportation (see www.tusd1.org/schoolchoice). Qualified neighborhood students may get free transportation if they live more than 1.5 miles from school for elementary/K-8, and more than 2.5 miles for middle/high school.
