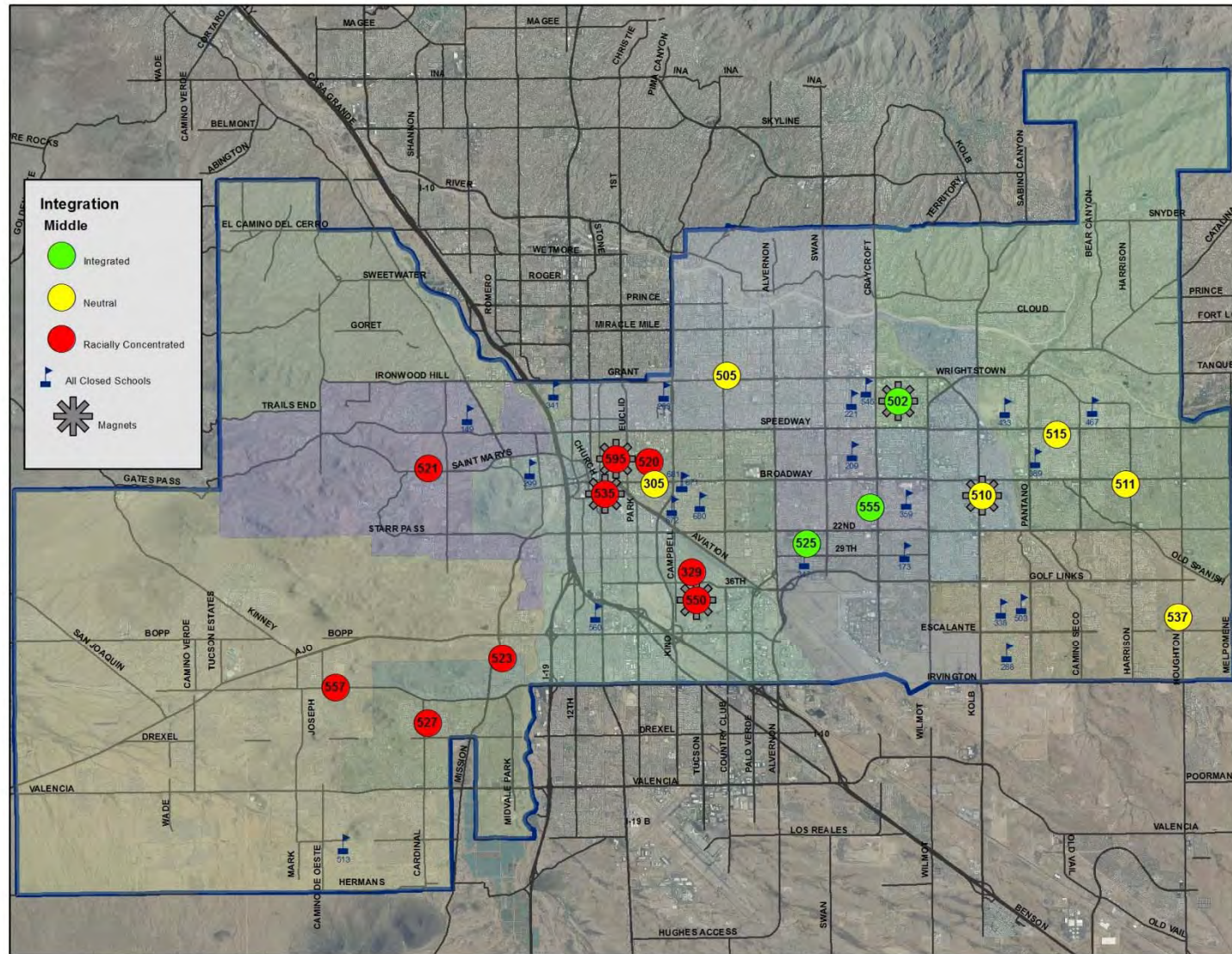
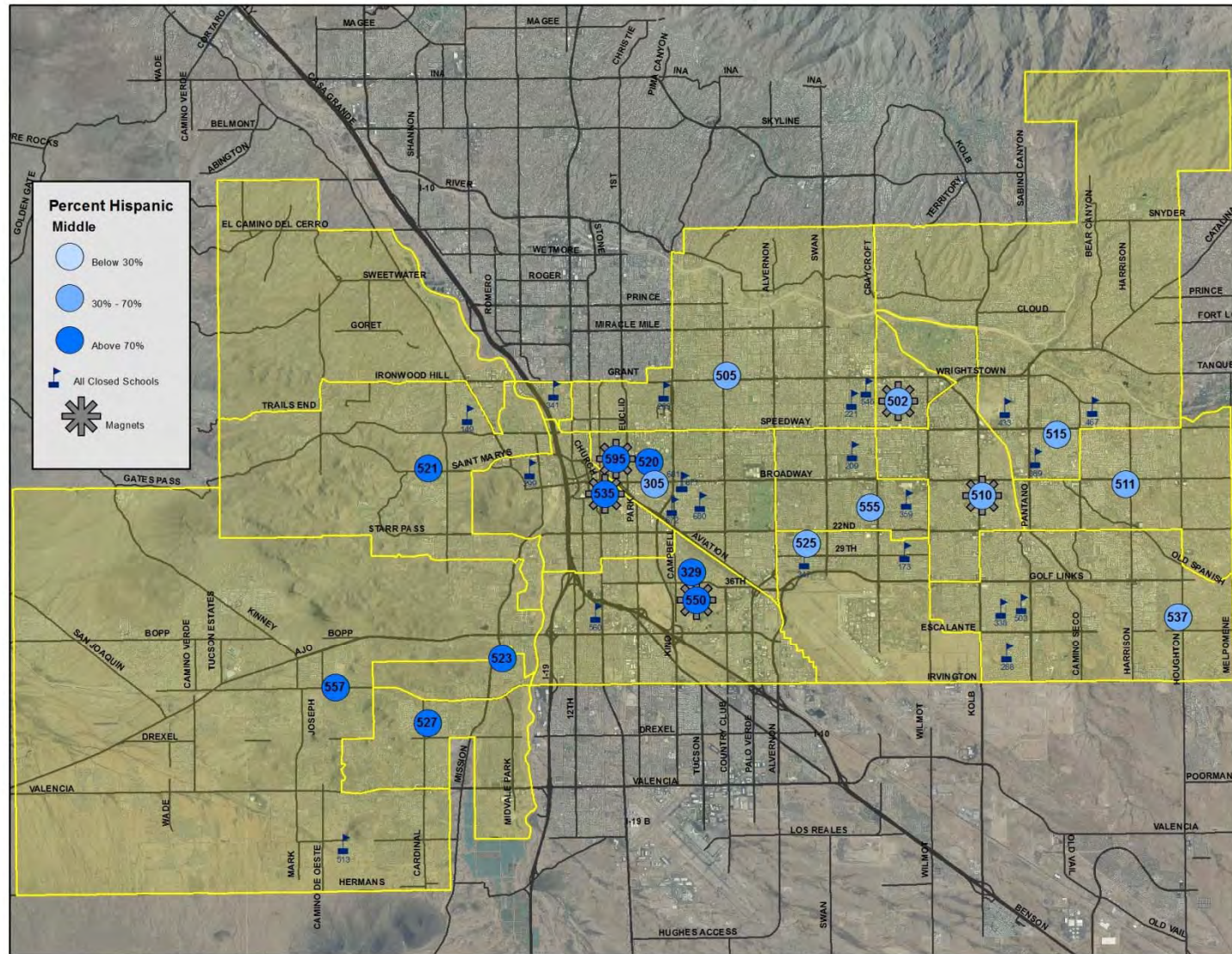

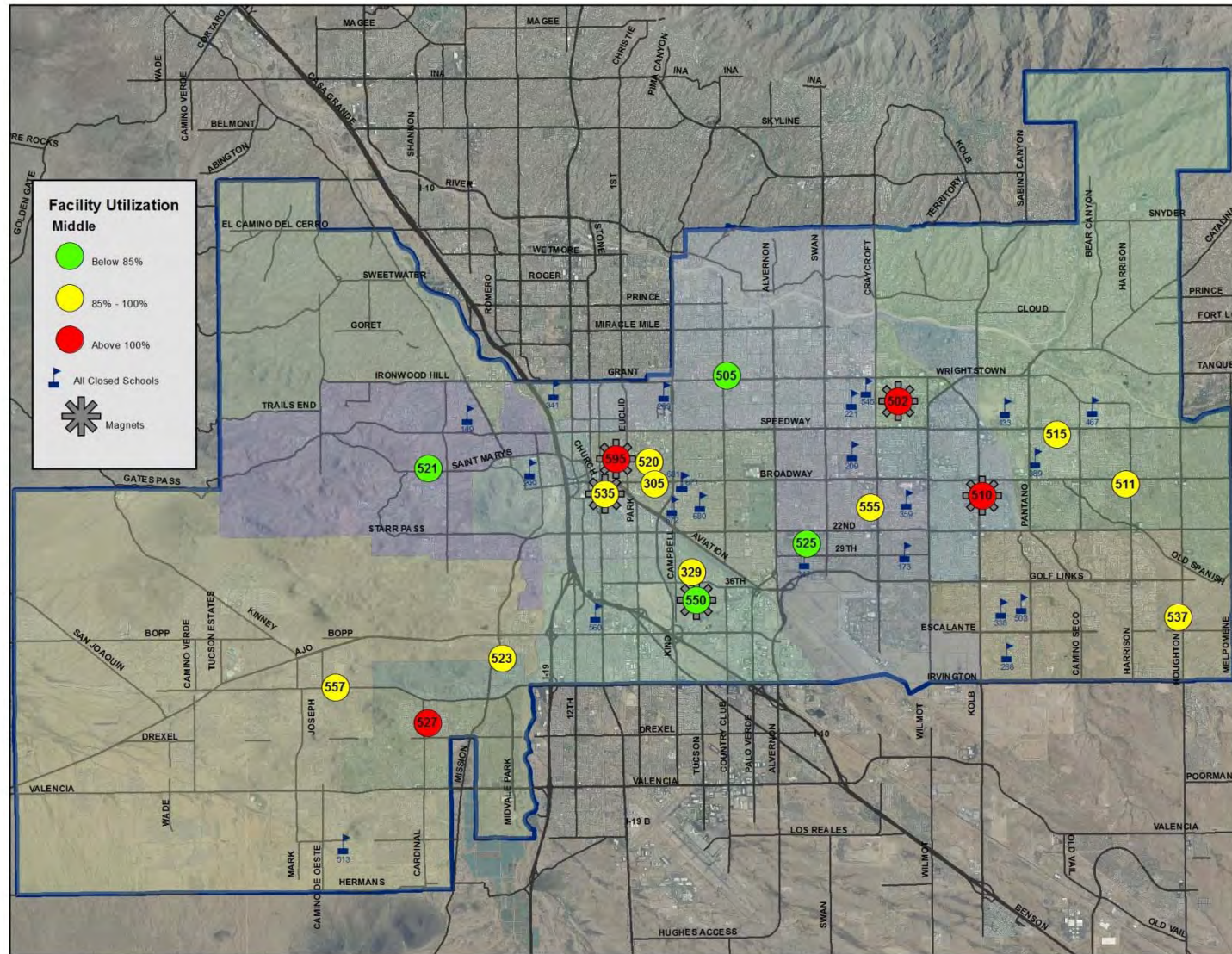
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# Middle: Percent Hispanic



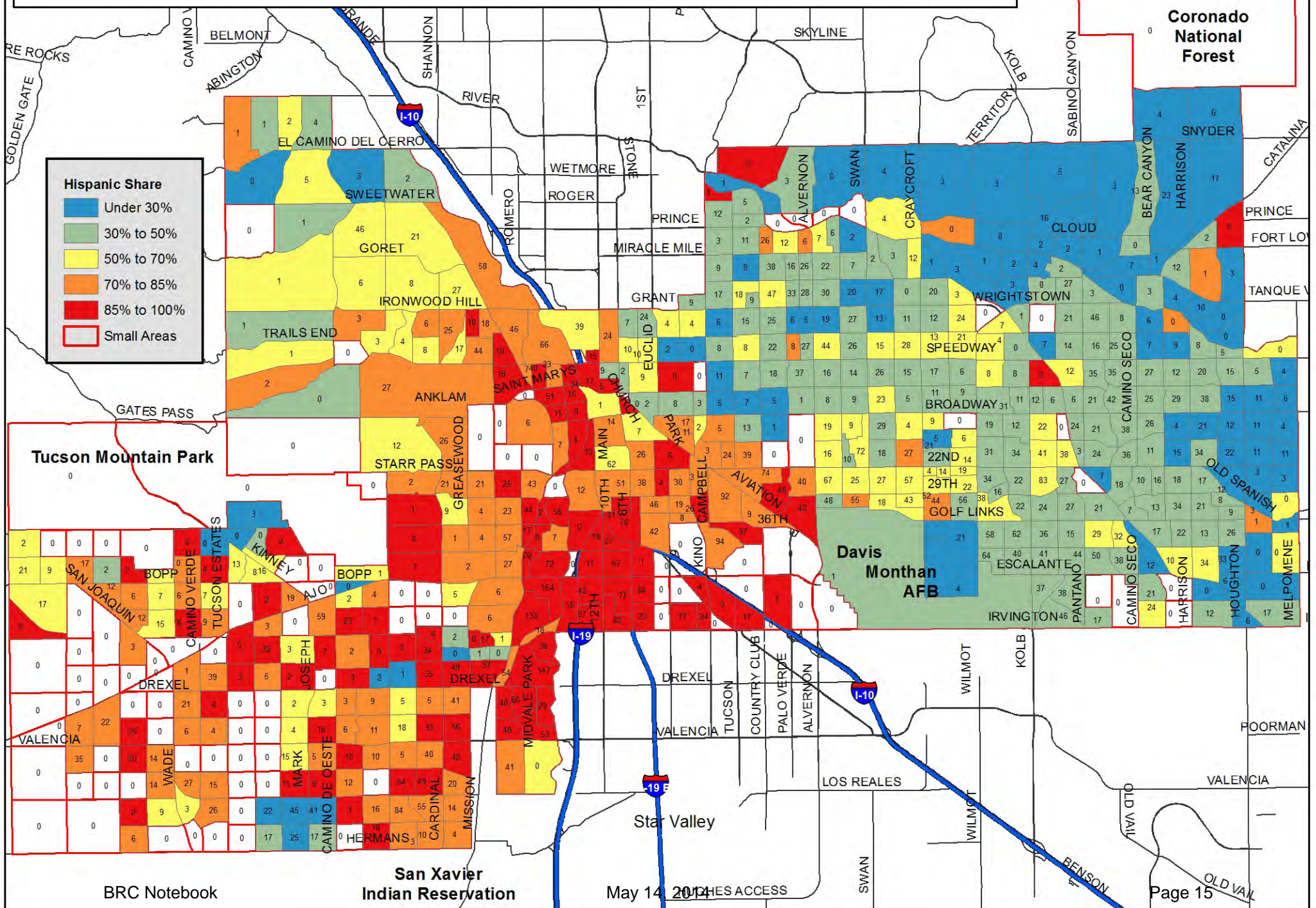

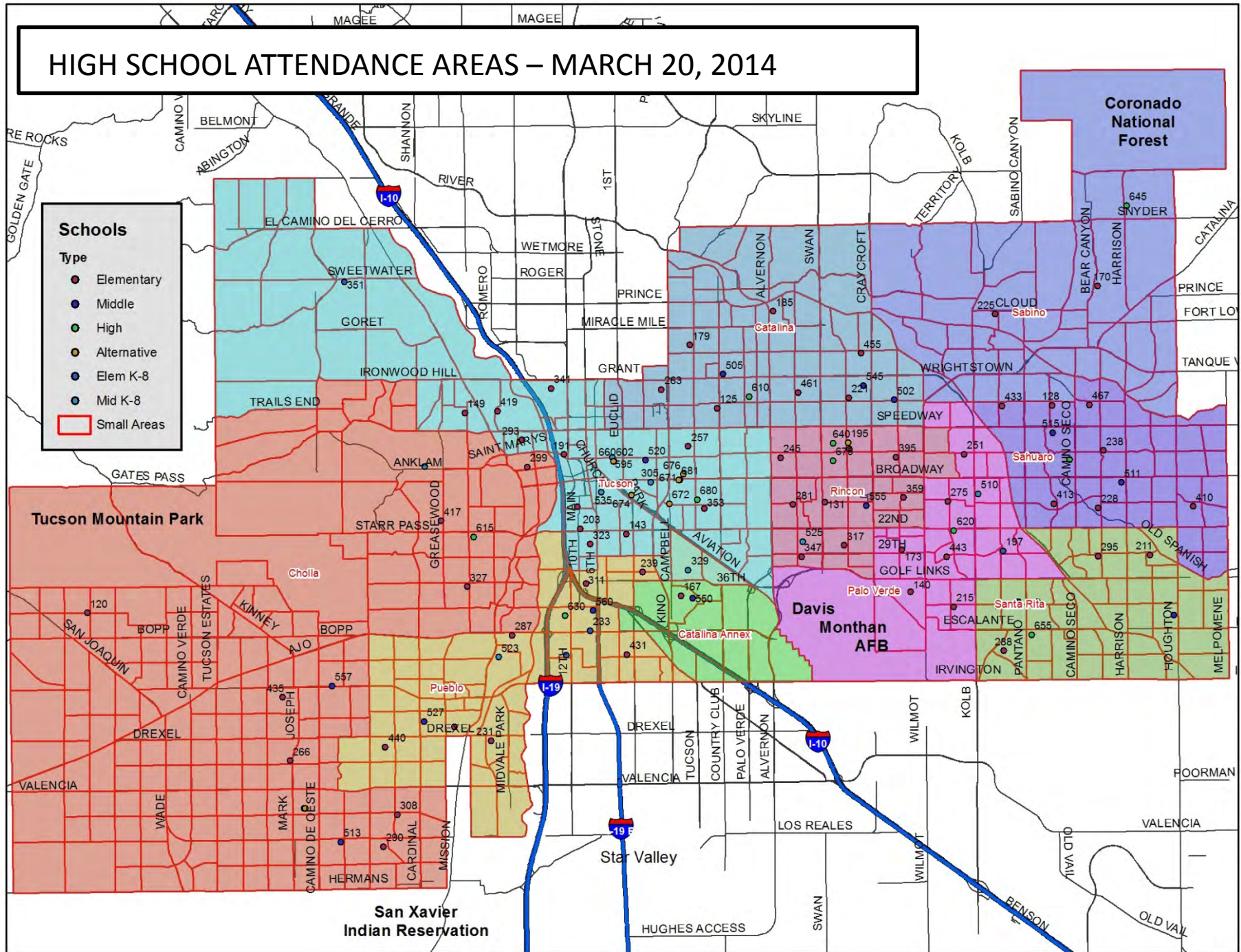
# Middle: Facility Utilization



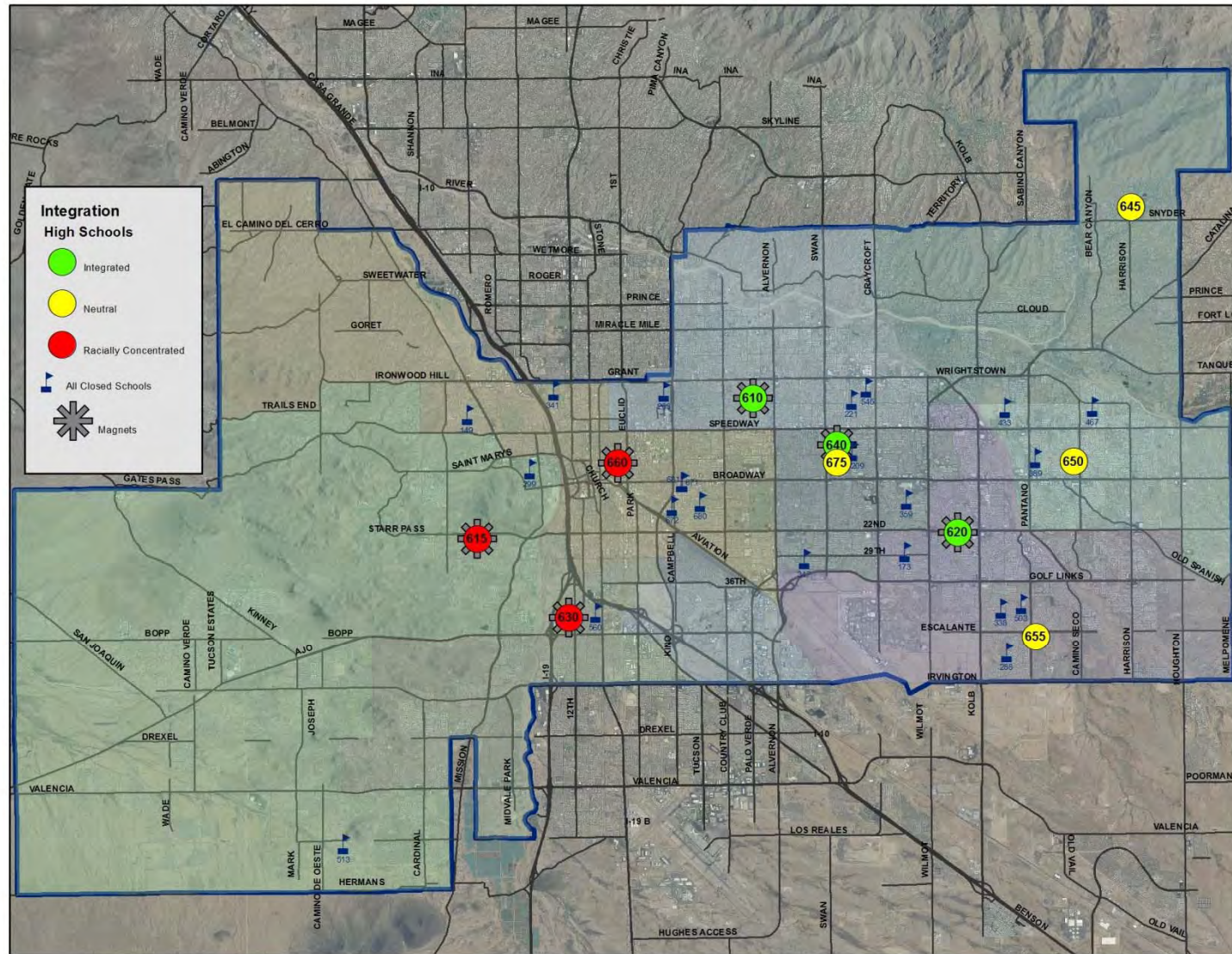

# HISPANIC SHARE OF ENROLLMENT AND 6-8 COUNT BY GRID



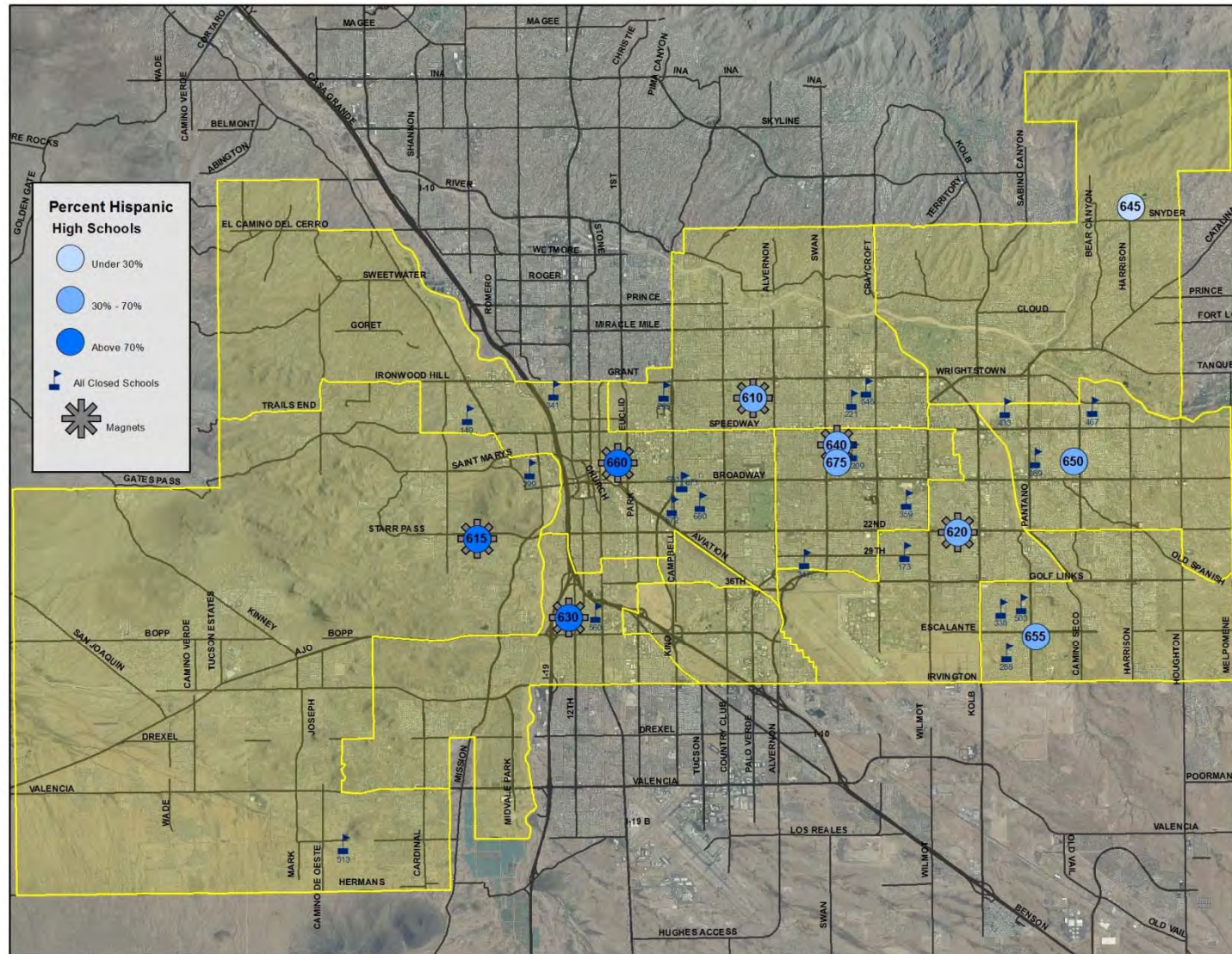


# High School: Integration Status



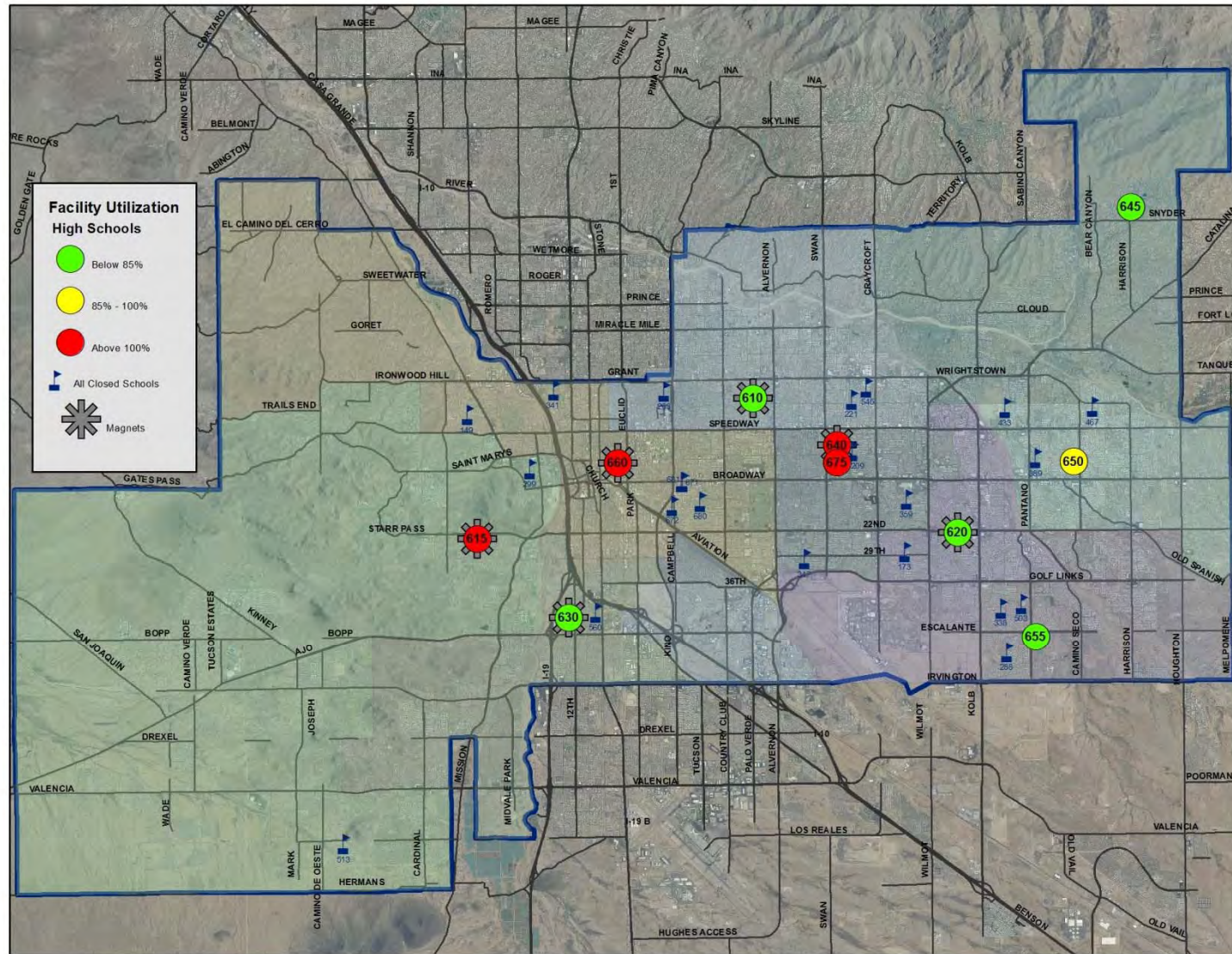
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# High School: Percent Hispanic

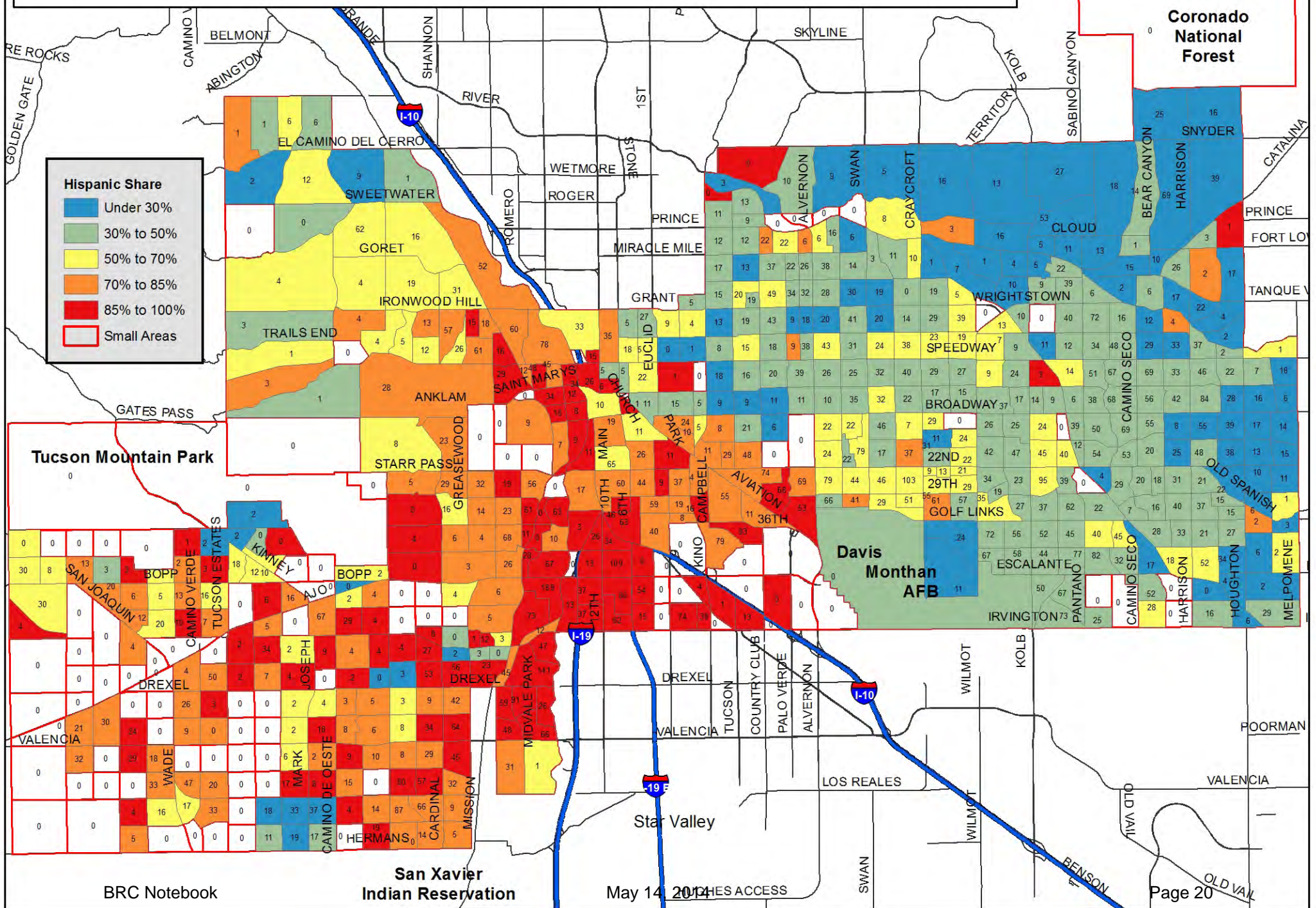
# High School: Facility Utilization

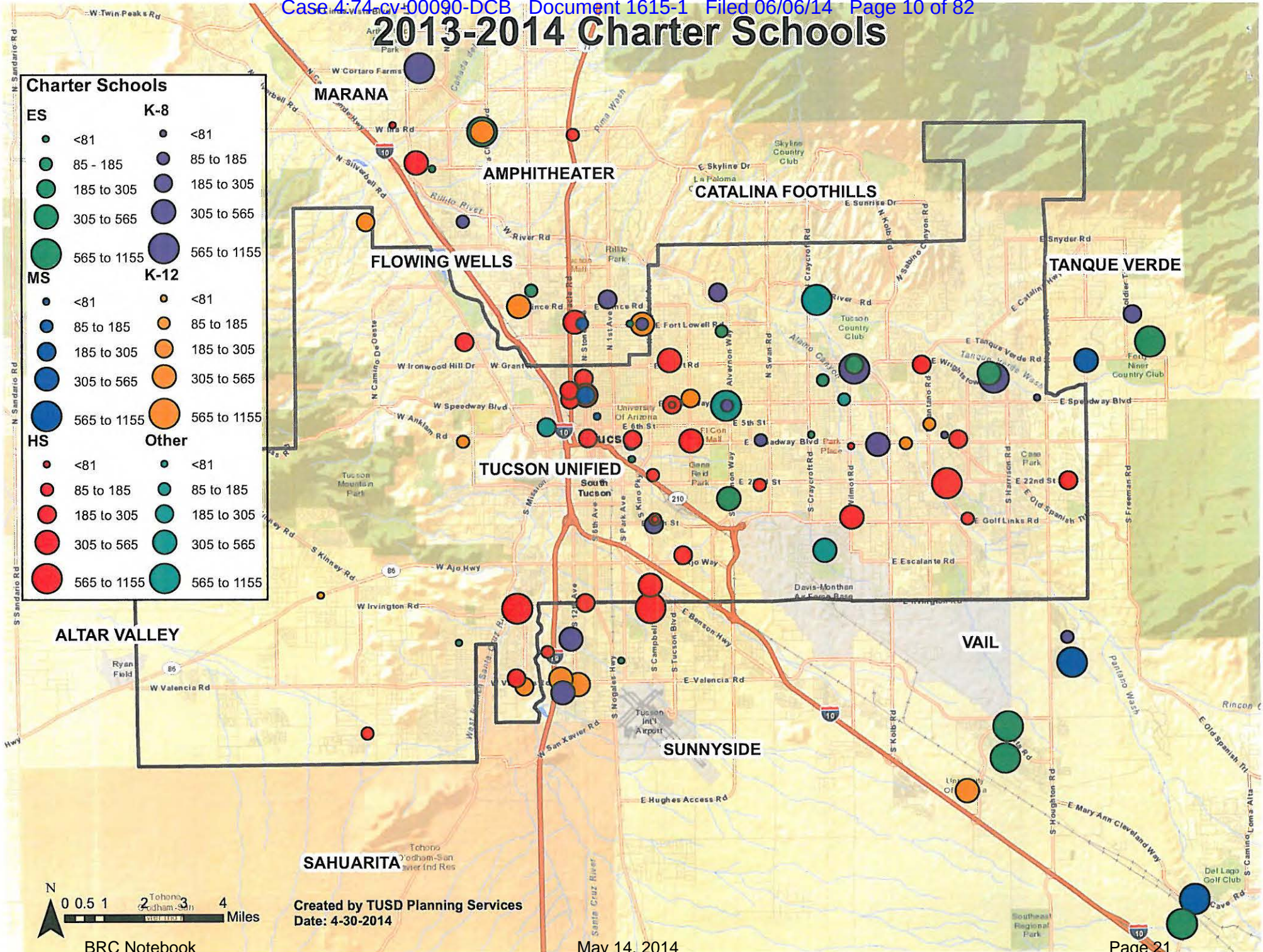
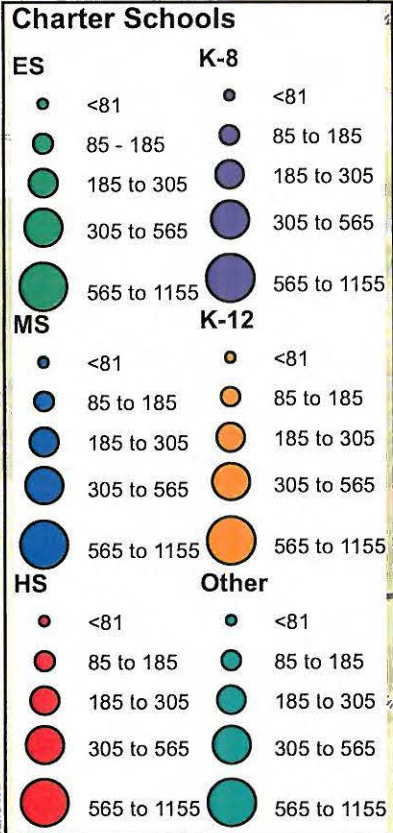
# HISPANIC SHARE OF ENROLLMENT AND 9-12 COUNT BY GRID

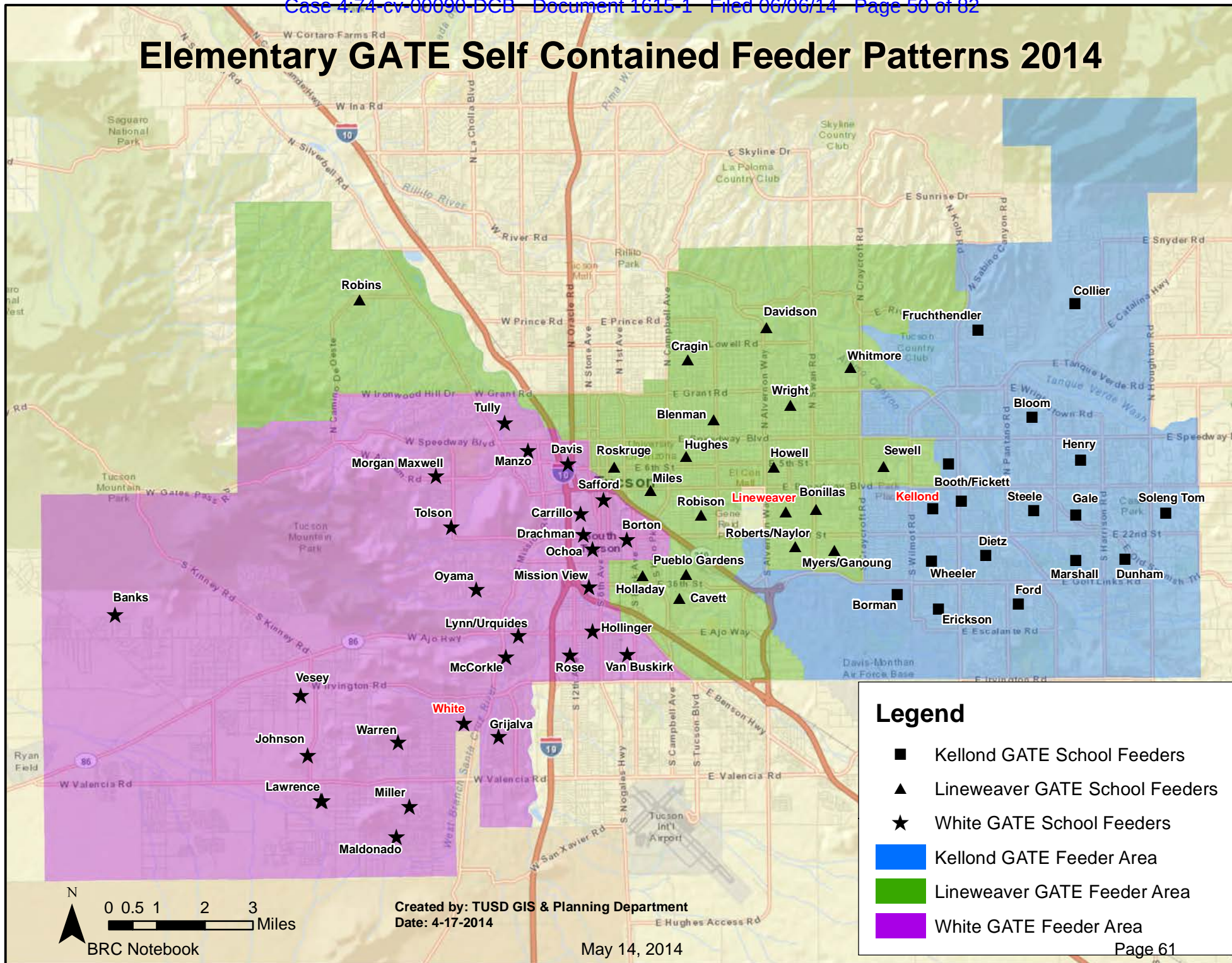

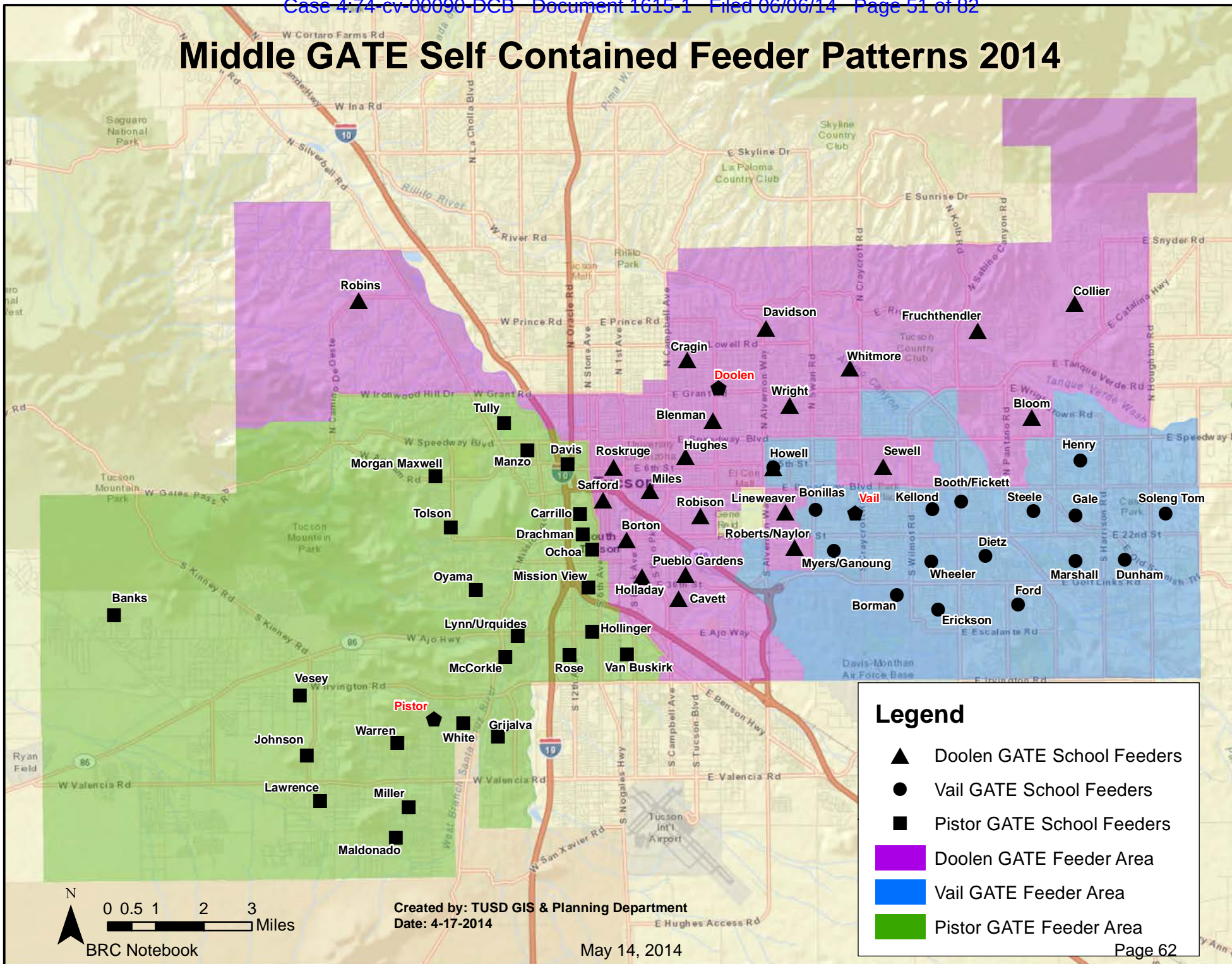

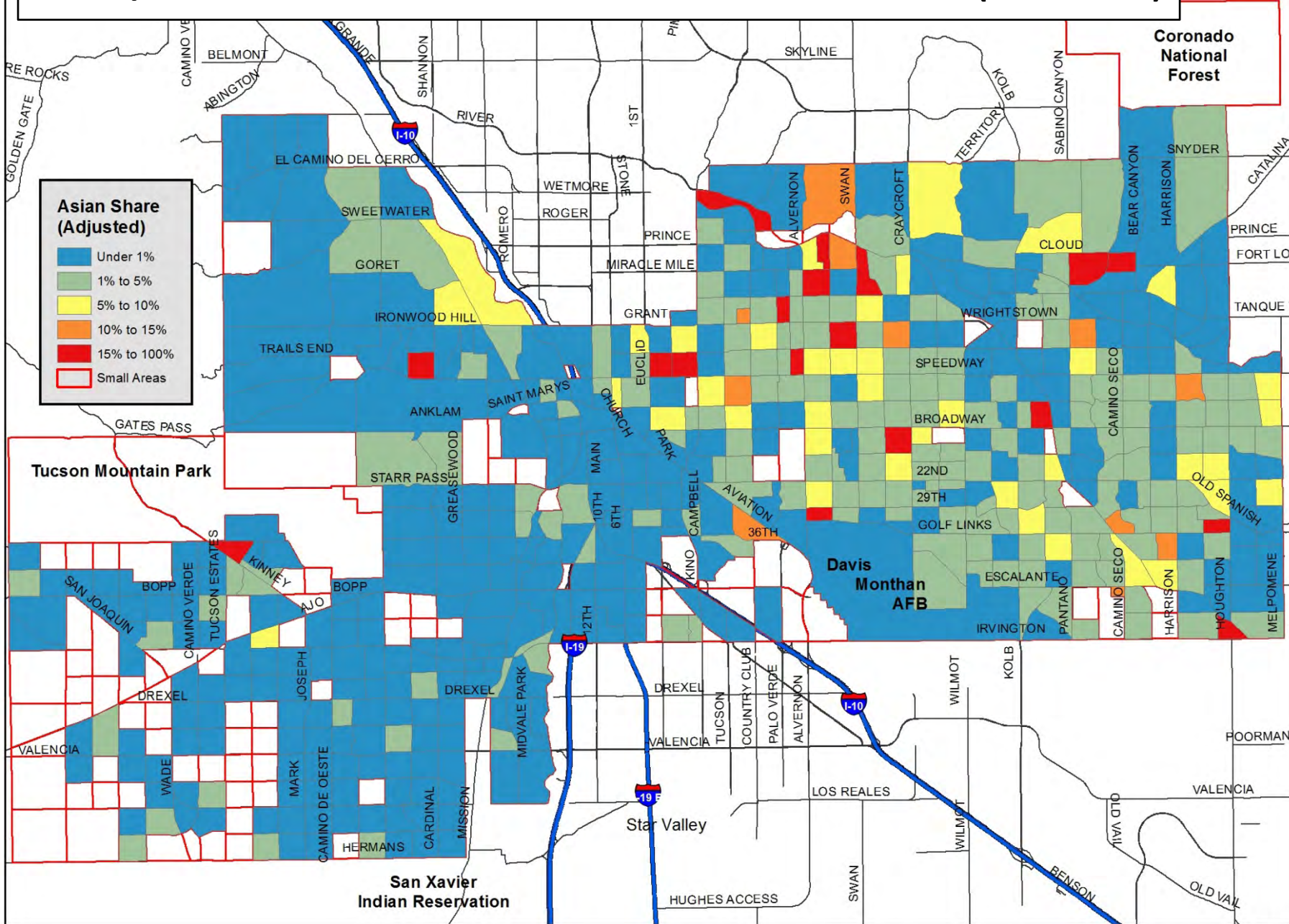


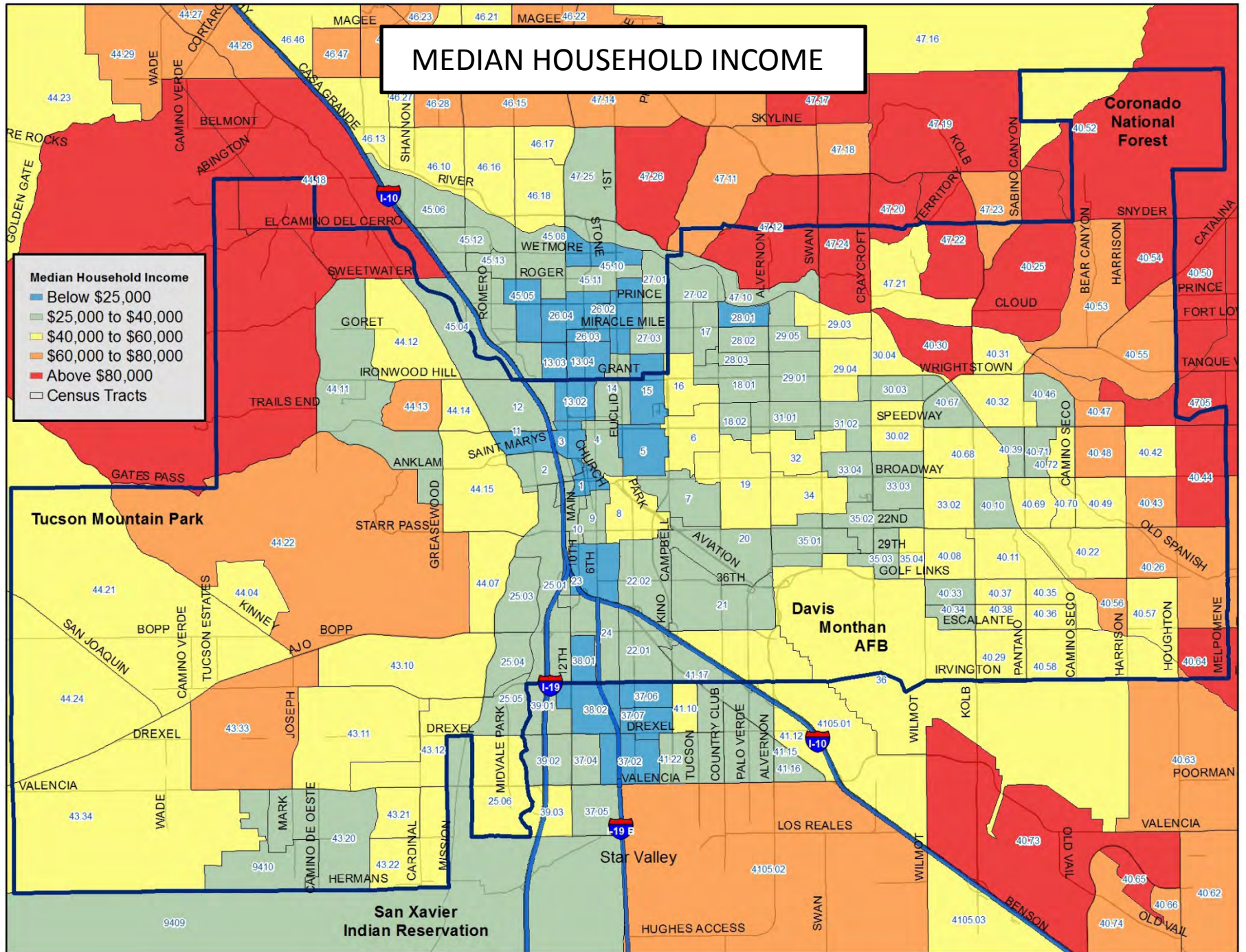
# AFRICAN-AMERICAN SHARE OF ENROLLMENT BY GRID (ADJUSTED)

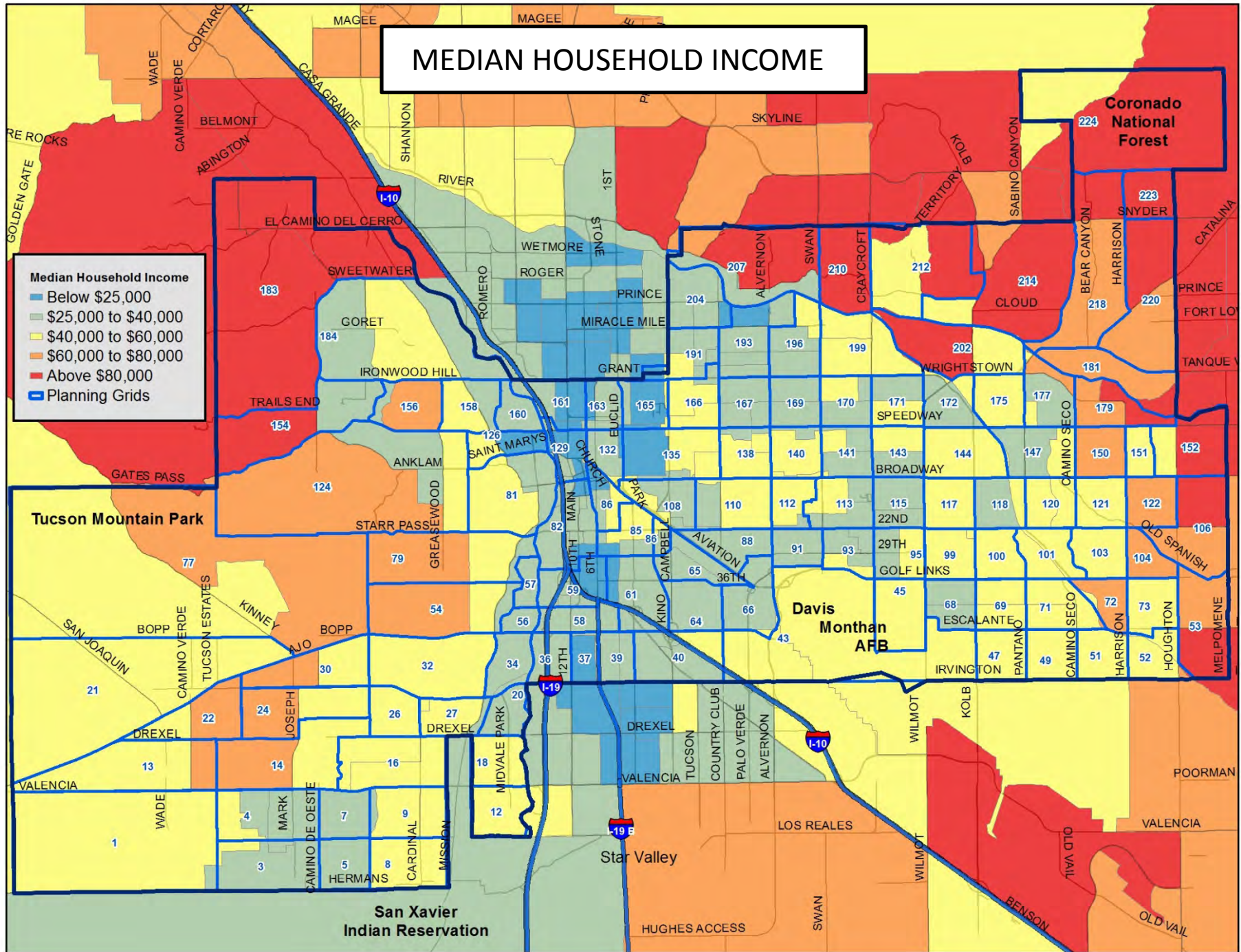




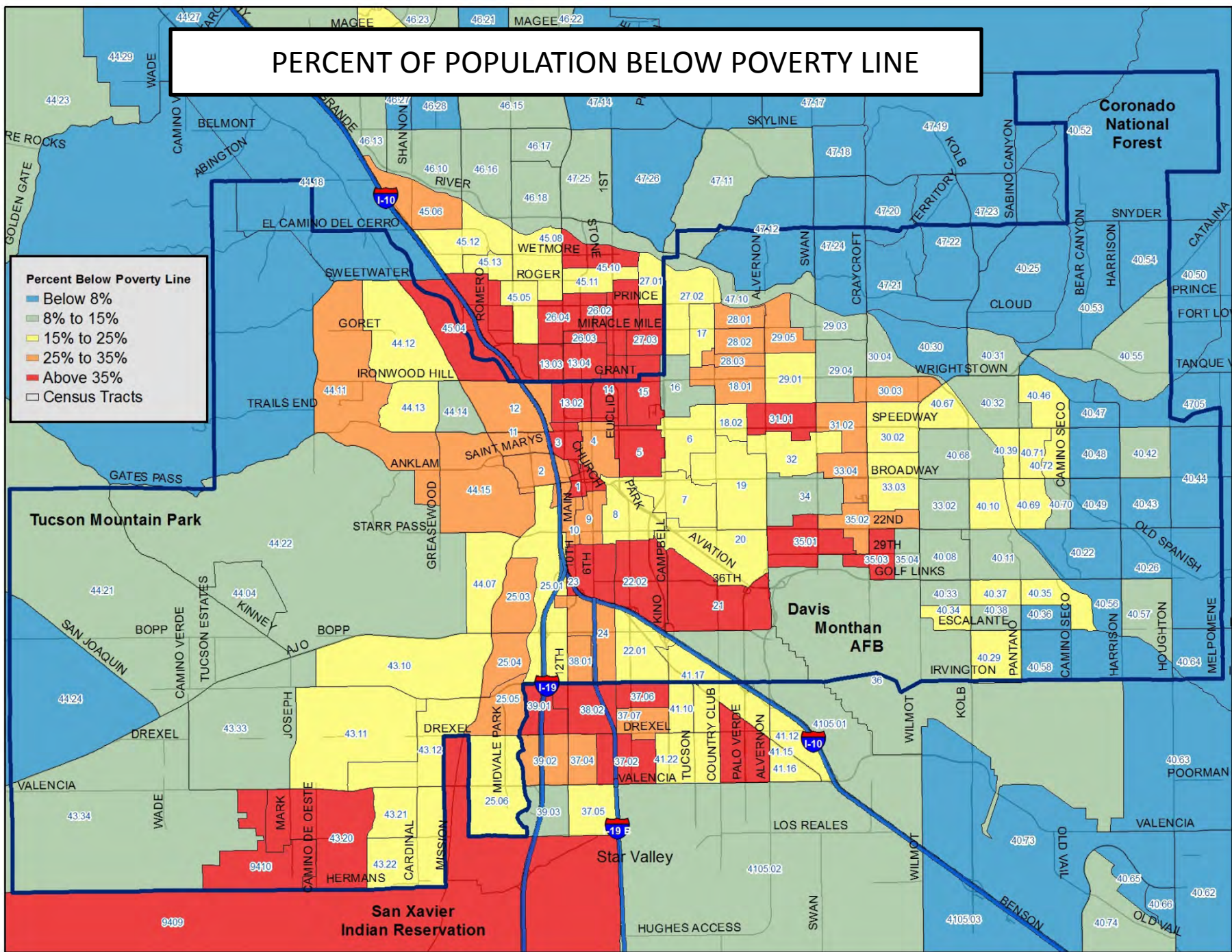
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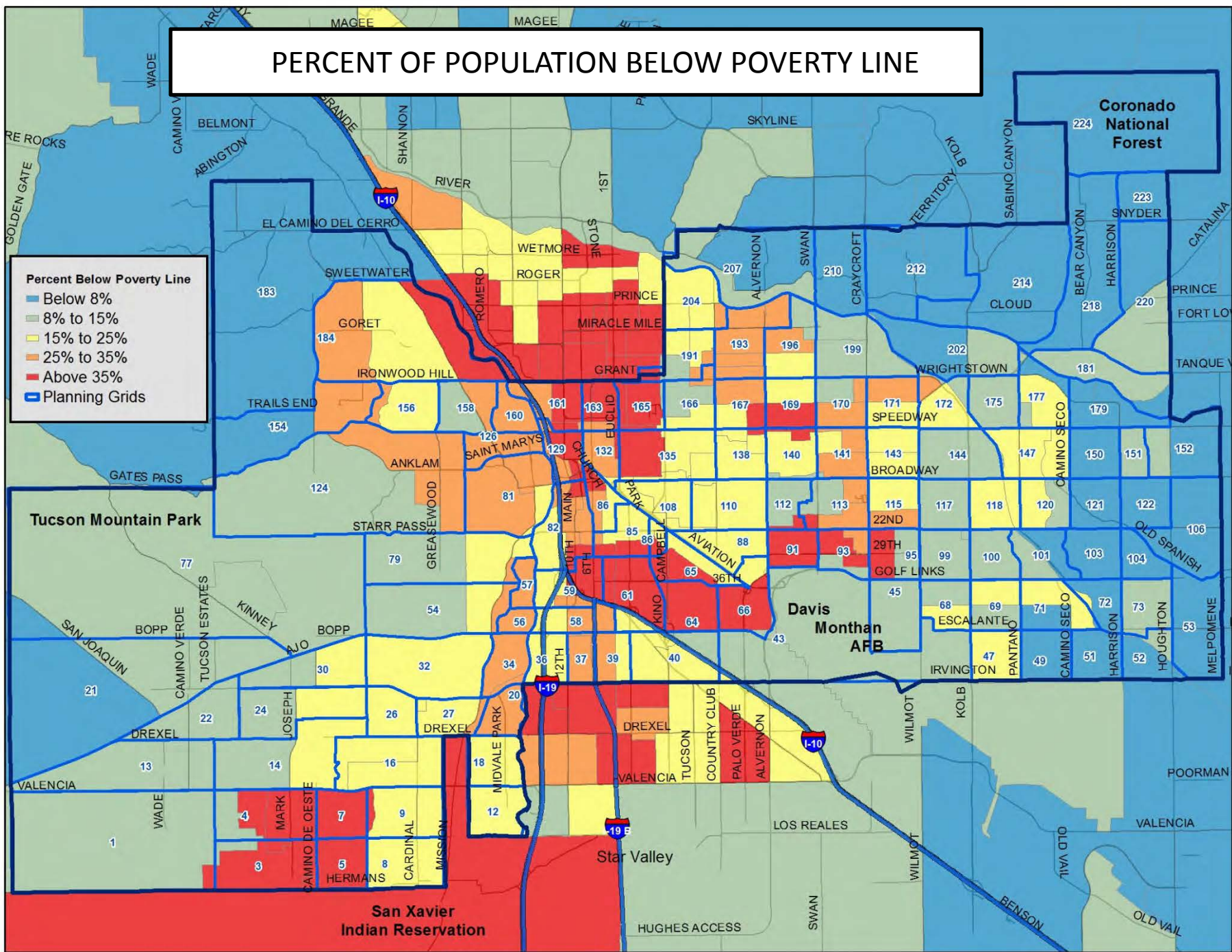


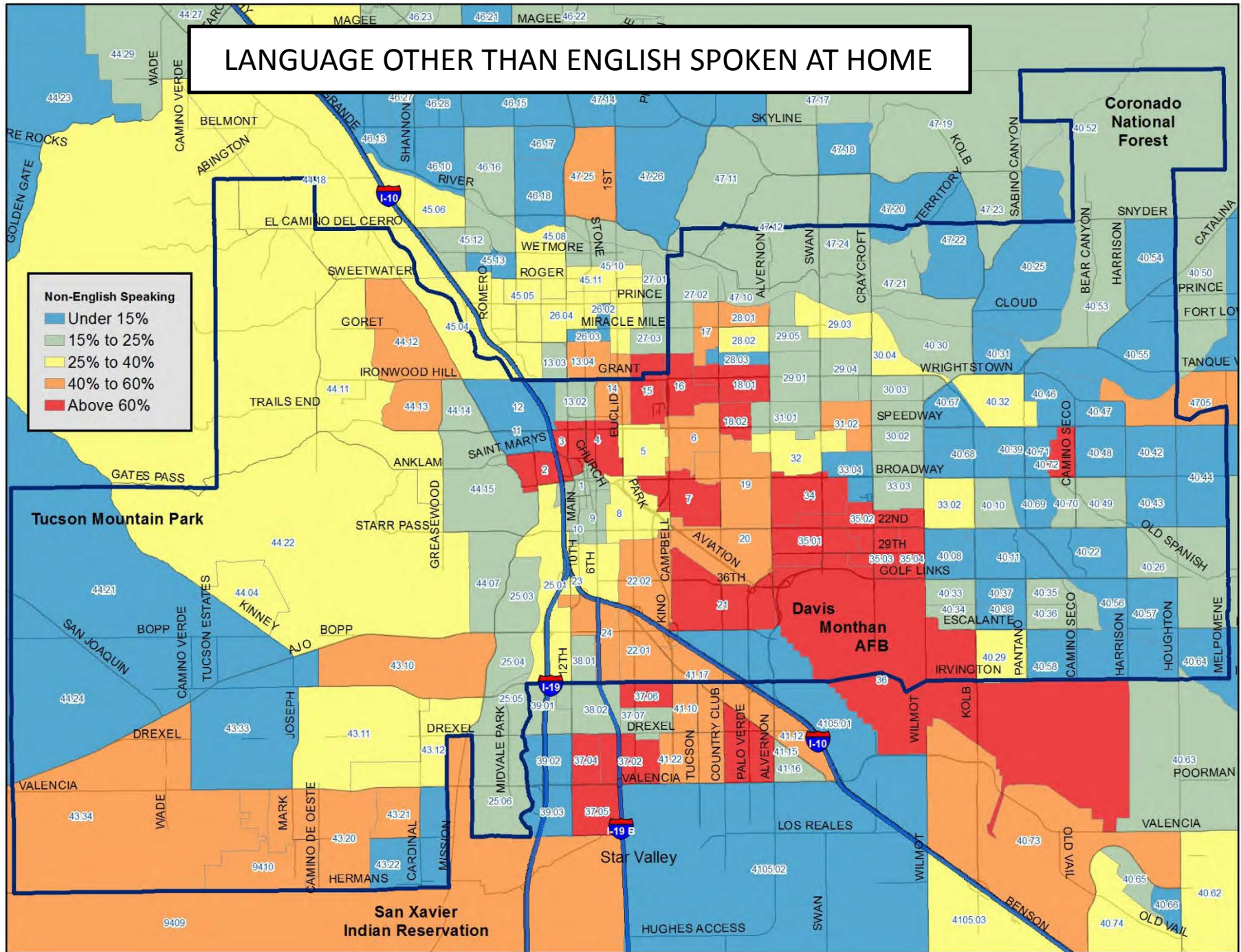


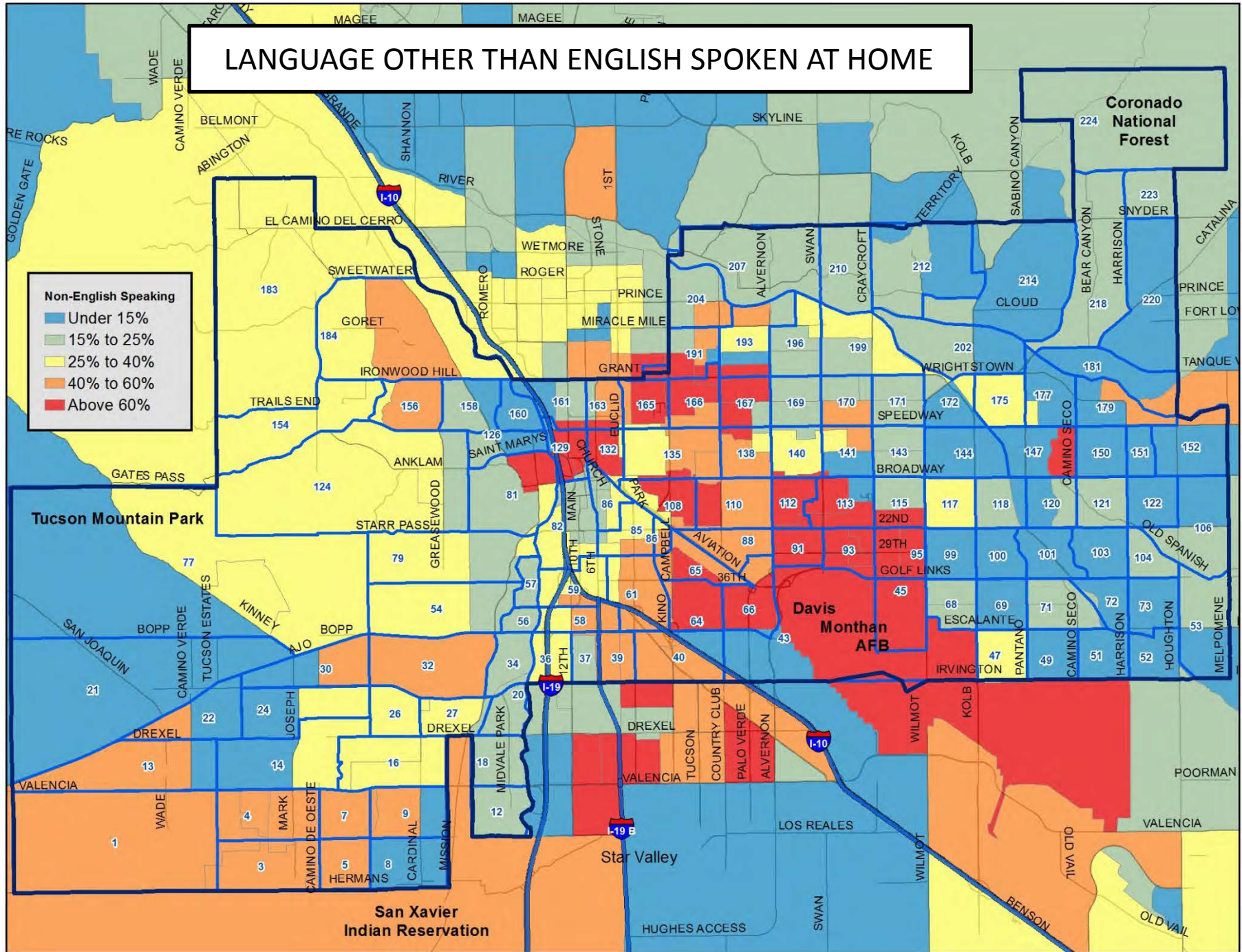
