IT IS ORDERED that the District's Supplementary Reply shall include the information requested by the Mendoza Plaintiff's for clarification concerning the sites at which middle school classes for high school credit actually are being held, how students are informed of such classes if the classes are not offered at their home schools, and enrollment data for 2018-2019 in such courses broken down by home school as well as student race/ethnicity, and to include information regarding the District's specific and actual use or planned actual use of the AGAVE program and the information upon which the District relied to determine its efficacy.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 7 days of the filing date of the District's Supplementary Reply, the Mendoza Plaintiffs may file a Sur-Supplementary Response and the Special Master's R&R shall follow accordingly.
