MISSION STATEMENT

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

At Agave Middle and High School we are working to build a strong partnership with the community at large, by engaging students, staff, families and others to help our students achieve their greatest potential. This policy outlines the way we will establish this partnership.

ANNUAL TITLE 1 MEETING

Agave staff will provide a copy of the Title 1 budget information to Title 1 families several times throughout the year, along with a review of the curriculum, assessments, requirements for proficiency, and opportunities for academic family involvement.

ANNUAL EVALUATION

Each year, the Agave Site Council will verify the progress made toward achieving the goals and expectations of both the School Compact and Parent Involvement Policy. Site Council will edit the documents for improved use the following year; parents are also encouraged to comment on the edits of the schools plans.

BUILDING ACADEMIC FAMILY INVOLVEMENT

Sharing the importance for student learning experiences ensures that all team members, including parents/guardians and the students themselves, are engaged in ways that promote and support student success. Throughout the year Agave will provide ample opportunities to involve families and students with academic support.

STUDENTS & FAMILIES

Agave will strive to develop relationships with all students, as well as their families. The school will hold an Open House and provide parent-teacher conferences (upon request), in order to give parents a chance to get acquainted with their students' teachers, school staff, and **other families**. Volunteer opportunities will be made available at these events.

FLEXIBLE MEETING SCHEDULE

Agave will hold meetings at various times and locations, for all families at once, and also one-on-one meetings when needed.

EFFECTIVE COMMUNICATION

Agave will organize a series of outreach programs including: parent webpage, email lists, special events, workshops and activities for parents to support their student's academic achievements. Agave will partner with community resources, volunteers and local businesses in order to strengthen families and our students' success not only in earning their High School Diploma but also in setting and achieving their future goals.

How It Works

AGAVE Middle & High School serves students in grades 6–12 and gives access to a complete curriculum. We offer scheduling flexibility, provide online access to coursework, and allow students to work at their own pace toward deadlines.

How it works, step-by-step:

1. **Click to start enrollment process now for AGAVE Middle & High School.**
2. When school begins, log in and work on your courses from an Internet-connected computer. Assignments, tests and quizzes are online 24/7.
3. Succeed at your own pace. Our curriculum is designed to suit various learning styles and skill levels. Meet due dates while working at your own speed.
4. Get real help when you need it. For each course, you are assigned an experienced, certified teacher who is accessible via virtual whiteboard, phone, email, or instant message (IM). You will also be assigned an Academic Advisor to keep on track.
5. Earn a diploma, or have the credits transferred to your traditional school. Upon completion of all required credits, your diploma will be issued by the Tucson Unified School District.

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
