The proposal will better serve TUSD's southwest community, increase enrollment in Johnson, and could have positive impacts on academic performance because students would not transition from Johnson to Lawrence 3-8 School in 3rd grade, the year they take the AzMERIT state assessments. The change will have no impact on the racial/ethnic composition of Johnson and the school has sufficient capacity to serve the additional students.

The change will not affect the racial/ethnic composition at Lawrence 3-8 School.

The Tucson Unified School District, No. 1 ("TUSD" or the "District"), hereby submits

As described in the Desegregation Impact Analysis (DIA), the purchase will have no impact on the District's ability to meet its desegregation obligations for surrounding schools or for the District as a whole. *See* Exhibit 1, Final Johnson DIA. The District submitted a draft DIA to the Special Master and Plaintiffs on February 1, 2019 to solicit feedback. No party objected to the proposal. The District submitted a final DIA to the Special Master and Plaintiffs on March 29, 2019. Again, no party objected to the proposal.

As this action will not negatively affect the District's ability to meet its USP obligations under student assignment, or any other USP area, and as no party has objected to this action, the District respectfully requests approval of the request to add third grade to Johnson beginning in the 2019-2020 school year.
