24 **NOTICE AND REPORT OF COMPLIANCE WITH**
25 **EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES COMPLETION PLAN**

1 The Court directed the District to file a notice and report of compliance with the
2 Court's directives its September 6, 2018, order, including the extracurricular activities
3 completion plan. [ECF 2123, at 132-137, 150-51.] The District prepared report of its
4 compliance with the extracurricular activities completion plan, and submitted it to the
5 Special Master for review and comment. The Special Master provided thoughts and
6 comments, along with additional requested provisions. The District further revised the
7 compliance report to take into account the input from the Special Master, as much as was
8 practicable in the circumstances. The resulting plan is attached hereto as Exhibit A.

9 The Special Master suggested adding enrollment numbers to the participation chart
10 that the District has used in annual reports. To ensure continuity, the District will continue
11 to report the chart without format change from prior versions, but will add a chart with
12 the enrollment numbers included.¹ The Special Master also suggesting adding gender as
13 a separate reporting category in the chart; here, there are significant practical difficulties,
14 as the District's method for collecting participation information from the schools does not
15 include gender, and would have to be redesigned; this would also raise the significant
16 issue about the number of genders to report and gender identification issues. Since
17 athletic activities are often heavily single gender, it is not clear what practical help this
18 information would provide, particularly in the context, and at this stage, of this
desegregation case.

19 The Special Master suggested that the District analyze the clubs at each school,
20 particularly on those that provide an academic focus (K-8 only), in order to determine if
21 additional central District support for academic clubs in needed at any identified school.
22 Though this goes beyond the completion plan, the District has agreed to do this, but not
23 as a requirement for unitary status.
