- 3. Plaintiffs shall have 30 days to file Responses/Objections to the Supplemental Petition for Unitary Status and the Executive Summary.
- 4. The District shall have 14 days to reply.
- 5. Thereafter, the Special Master shall have 30 days to file a Report and Recommendation.
- 6. All parties may file Replies/Objections to the R&R within 14 days of the filing of the Special Master's Report and Recommendation.

This order does not address pending matters relating to the budget, which are governed by the Court's budget order (ECF 2272) and any subsequent orders related thereto.
