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The Tucson Unified School District, No. 1 ("TUSD" or the "District"), hereby submits 3 this Response to Responses filed by the Department of Justice (DOJ) and the Mendoza Plaintiffs related to the District's Notice and Request for Approval (NARA) to open a new 4 5 career-oriented high school in collaboration with Pima County Joint Technical Education District (JTED)(the "Bridges HS") [ECF 2336]. 6

7 The DOJ does not object to the proposal, stating "upon careful consideration of 8 TUSD's Desegregation Impact Analysis of the proposal, the United States does not oppose 9 the District's Notice and Request for Approval..." [ECF 2356 at 2:5-7]. The Fisher Plaintiffs 10 did not file a response. The Mendoza Plaintiffs "do not object to the District's undertaking to partner with JTED to offer TUSD students, including members of the plaintiff classes, the opportunity to attend a high school offering Career and Technical Educational ("CTE") programs that prepare those students for meaningful employment in 21st century workplaces." [ECF 2361 at 2:11-15]. 14

15 The Mendoza Plaintiffs identify several conditions upon which they believe approval 16 should be based. The District has no objection to any of these conditions, as most of them 17 include actions TUSD plans to take or, in some cases, has already taken. The District is 18 already working to develop strategies to integrate the Bridges that include marketing, 19 outreach, recruitment, an express bus, and a modified lottery. The District has already 20 reached out to Dr. Gary Orfield who has agreed to review the District's marketing and 21 recruitment plan, and to consult with the District. The District has already planned for, and 22 hereby commits to: applying its Teacher Diversity Plan to the Bridges HS and seeking to hire 23 and retain a diverse staff (there will only be a single TUSD administrator); applying its Code 24 of Conduct, PBIS, Restorative Practices, and related policies and practices to all students 25 during the school day; providing the same discipline and CRP training to Bridges HS teachers 26 as provided in other high schools; and offering CRC courses.

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## Conclusion

For the reasons stated above, and those outlined in its Notice and Request for Approval,

the District respectfully requests approval to open the Bridges HS in SY 2020-21.
