ORDER

1 Having considered the Motion for Reconsideration of Order Regarding 3-Year
2 PIP, CMP, Transportation and ORR Addendums filed by Defendant Tucson Unified
3 School District No. 1 (the “District”),

4 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Order entered June 4, 2020 regarding
5 3-Year PIP, CMP, Transportation and ORR Addendums (ECF 2471) (the “Order”) is
6 modified as follows:

7 1. The provisions of the Order eliminating magnet status for Booth-Fickett are
8 hereby rescinded, and the Court requests that the District treat Booth-Fickett as an
9 improving but not yet satisfactory magnet school.

10 2. All other mandatory portions of the Order are hereby rescinded, and the
11 Court requests that the District consider the recommendations by the Special Master in
12 his Report and Recommendation (ECF 2469) and the statements by the Court in the
13 Order as a guide in the administration of its magnet program henceforth.
