A review of the Court docket reflects two Reports and Recommendations which remain pending that are moot because of the Court's recently issued Order, 3-Year PIP: CMP (Doc. 2471). The Court has ordered the District to assess the merits of magnet status for Holladay ES pursuant to the clarifications made for defining Integration. (Order (Doc. 2471) at 13.) The District shall also assess the merits of magnet status for Roskruge K-8 because it is Racially Concentrated and a AZMerit C school. Id. at 12, 13. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Report and Recommendation by the Special Master regarding magnet status for Roskruge K-8 (Doc. 2274) is MOOT.
