On June 18, 2020, the District's Supplemental Petition for Unitary Status (Doc. 2406) was fully briefed. On June 24, 2020, the Special Master filed a Response explaining that there are issues addressed by the Plaintiffs in their Objections, which he did not address or did not address fully in his Report and Recommendation (R&R), including alternative measures suggested by the Plaintiffs as being required under the Unitary Status Plan (USP). He would also like an opportunity to correct misunderstandings or misstatements made by the Plaintiffs as to certain recommendations he made in the R&R. The Court finds that this further briefing, or Reply, from the Special Master would be helpful to the Court.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the Response treated as a Motion for Leave to File a Reply to Objections to the R&R Re: Supplemental Petition for Unitary Status (Doc. 2484) is GRANTED to be filed by: July 6, 2020.
