TUCSON UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT DESEGREGATION IMPACT ANALYSIS Sam Hughes K-5 School – Portable

Action: Adding one double-wide portable (two classrooms) to provide more students with an opportunity to attend Sam Hughes Elementary, an integrated school, and to accommodate increases in enrollment.

Summary: Sam Hughes Elementary School is an integrated, high-demand, oversubscribed, B-rated school that remains at or over capacity every year. The District has experienced steady enrollment declines, and is seeking to provide more students with an opportunity to attend a high-demand integrated school, and to provide better services to students by relieving over-crowding issues.

A. Impact Analysis

In 2019-20, there are 188 K-5 students living in the Sam Hughes attendance area. Lineweaver enrolls 10 of these students. Slightly more than 17% of these students attend other non-TUSD schools.

Sam Hughes Enrollment

As shown in the table below, Sam Huges is integrated. Hughes operated over its design capacity in SY2019-20 by approximately 50 students. Without the addition of one double-wide portable, Sam Hughes will continue to operate over capacity by approximately 70 students.

B. Analysis of how the proposed change will impact District obligations under the USP

- 7. Family and Community Engagement No potential impact.

- 10. **Accountability and Transparency** No potential impact (the funds needed to move the portable will come from plant funds)

C. Data Sources

The enrollment data is the SY2019-20 fortieth-day enrollment (as school is not yet in session, physically, it is difficult to estimate 2020-21 enrollment at this time). The design capacities provided are the number of classrooms over 650 square feet times 25 students per classroom. These indicate the potential capacity of the school; operating capacities are often lower.

D. Assumptions

Ethnic compositions of the change components mirror the ethnic composition of the students in the grades of that school.
