The Defendant Tucson Unified School District (the District) has submitted three Notice and Request for Approvals (NARA) to add portable class rooms at Bloom Elementary School, Borman K-8 and Hughes K-5 schools. The District provides desegregation impact analysis (DIAs) for each proposal, which reflect no significant affect on desegregation at these schools or surrounding schools. The Court notes these are all good schools (B and C schools) that offer an integrated or nearly integrated academic experience.

There are no objections, except the Defendant reports that the Fisher Plaintiffs object generally to portables as being inconsistent with the USP. The Fisher Plaintiffs did not file any objection with the Court to the NARA requests.

Accordingly,

IT IS ORDERED that the NARA requesting to add one double-wide portable (two classrooms) at Bloom Elementary (Doc. 2523) is APPROVED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the NARA requesting to add one double-wide portable (two classrooms) at Borman K-8 School (Doc. 2541) is APPROVED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the NARA requesting to add one double-wide portable (two classrooms) at Sam Hughes Elementary (Doc 2542) is APPROVED.
