Highly upsetting when there was a conflict, no one would talk to my child's Dad or myself about it (we co-parent), we were told we could have a meeting about it next week when we wanted answers today about the multiple issues that happened the day before. No phone call about behavior or when he had an wet accident because the teacher wouldn't allow him to use the restroom after he asked. My older child, who is a freshman now, went here to Dunham, never had a problem, we both loved the school but that was also with a different principal. So its been very disappointing how things have been handled and now we aren't comfortable sending my son there any longer. We went to a different school as of today!

Hollinger has great admin and staff!! Hollinger has been a great placement for my son who is the GATE/Dual language program. I would like to see progress reports and more GATE projects in his class.

Honestly I do stuff with my child. He is in high school, not elementary. I think you are trying and trying and probably stressing out your staff with parent engagement that's not necessarily needed. Offer it. Whoever shows up, shows up. Parents are working and trying to spend time with their kids in no school related activities. You giving the parents more to do isn't going to help the student. It's going to make a bitter, more stressed out parent. Stop coming up with problems just to do it. Give your teachers and parents a break.

I am very disappointed in the TUSD Staff and teacher, Mobile or remote learning as we the Parents have been in Contact with the staff and teachers. I am concerned for our child's Education with how many breaks she gets during the whole day while on Virtual Learning. We have emailed the Teacher through the laptop that was provided by TUSD, We have sent her multiple emails with questions or concerns on what to accomplish. It can take anywhere from 1 day to 1 week before we get a response back from the Teacher.

I am very disappointed in TUSD putting \$\$ ahead of the health and welfare of my child, especially without taking into consideration parental requests. I am very disappointed in how unavailable the Board has been and unwilling to listen to parent requests. I am thankful this is my last year in a TUSD school and have nothing good to say about them.

I currently have 4 children attending Cragin and I am very pleased with the teachers and especially the principal!

I did not get good communication from Mr. De Leon when I asked about tutoring, Mrs. Gallegos said my child needed tutoring.

I do not feel safe sending my child to Sabino as the students and staff tend not to wear masks. It is very unfortunate that the schools principal does not enforce it or set an example of masking and vaccinating.

I have a concern that the mask regulation is doing more harm to the children's health than good.

I have had multiple children attend Sabino High School over the past ten years. This is the first year I have been thoroughly disappointed in the schools culture, climate, administration and academia. It is very unfortunate to watch an amazing school become mediocre at best with little or no regard to students who strive for excellence and want to achieve.

I have had no issues with Henry.

I have no complaints with the teachers, but I wish the attendance office staff could be a little more friendly when I call the office. It feels like it is an inconvenience whenever I call.

I like Mansfeld and have received very good support for my child. Thank you.

I like this school but it is difficult to advocate for your child if you have an impasse with a teacher. There is, what I feel, no room for criticism or conflict. It is clear that the teacher is never wrong and that kids don't often get a chance to remedy a wrong without a harsh consequence. Although I appreciate the hard work teachers put into the students, there is little room to grow, as an individual or choices that they can make as young people with such a super controlled environment. It is also hard to create relationships with teachers unless you really go out of your way or have a few years to be on a committee of some sort. Parents aren't very welcome at meetings at all.

I look forward to being more involved as my health improves. I have my parent teacher conference tonight. Mrs Osborne has done a superior job in communicating with my and helping my child to adjust and adapt to Arizona, we are grateful to be Cougars!

I love Howell, if I enter the school or call on any given day almost everyone will know who my child is and they are always so friendly. My child loves going to school everyday!

I love this school and so does my daughter but I would appreciate it if teachers walked the kids where they needed to go. My daughter's teacher, Mrs. Vieira is great and always keeps me up dated on my daughter's learning and etc.

I will say the only reason that I do not have the problems that the other black and Brown/Hispanic American and African American students and their parents deal with this because I am an advocate for education I believe in staying deeply rooted in what is going on when it's concerns Concerns my child and her education. With being a former teacher myself warmer teacher myself though I like the elementary school that my daughter goes to but they do not take a deep rooted concern in the African American and hispanic children. I am APT a member and I notice that there are no voices and no aspect that is taken For these cultural groups. Also even though it is stated that My daughter's elementary school is supposed to be a Blue Ribbon certified school, Amongst its African American and Latino students they all exhibit low reading scores and low mass scores., I had many complaints about her teacher because of her racist attitude and her separation of the races within her classroom though it was online. Needless to Say this year that teacher is no longer there, But the presence of the separation of the ethnic groups is still very prevalent. I am new to Tucson and this is very disappointing as an African American mother. Because I believe that if it wasn't for my authority and my deep rooted concern about her education and her welfare as far as her learning and then wanting her To succeed in her education she would fall behind as many of the African American and Latino students are. I've seen 1st hand how the effort is put forth for the white children but not so much for the African American and Latina students.

I wish I had gotten an email about the exact start dates for different sports.

I wish the Johnson school staff would be present during morning drop off. It would allow traffic flow to be consistent and ensure all students get into the building safe. At my son's school White elementary, all staff is present in the morning drop off area. Their staff opens car doors for students

and guides them safely into the building, it really shows they care.

I work too many hours. I'm going to try and make more time and get more involved

I would like if any counselor can help my child to choose a career.

I would like my son to be able to go mask free

I would love to conference with my child's teachers, but was not contacted to set up a conference. I realize that if a student is doing well he or she may not "need" a conference, but I would still appreciate a chance to talk with each teacher. I hesitate to bother them outside conference times because I know they are very busy. Also, more reminders about PTO meetings would be great! Maybe a robocall or an email the day of. Overall, my child is having a great first year at middle school. Thank you!

I would really appreciate if all communication could occur in one platform. It is so hard to keep track of all activity when I have to monitor 5 different avenues for communication with teachers.

I'll start with question #5 I CAN reach out and ask for specific information. Yes there is ParentVue. I have actually wanted to pull my hair out and start therapy due to the lack of updated information. I know the teachers are busy and this is still a very touchy time with COVID. If I contact the teacher for information they have all been very good to respond. I reached out to the counselor for my child due to falling grades, sports participation, anxiety, and they said that they would meet with your student, still nothing, it's been 6 weeks. The biggest failure for the parent in my eyes is the lack of communication for the sports programs. Practice days and times. Game days. Cancellation of games. If they are being transported to another school, what is the return time? I have 3 elementary sibling/students with activities during the week. I have sat in the HS parking lot for 30-45 min waiting on athlete with no notification of delay. I think this is horrible. I expect my child/your student/athlete to give to what he has committed to and he can expect to be supported by me, the teachers/staff/coaches can depend that we will do our best to participate and be committed to the school and team requirements. My child does not drive and I would rather not send him on a city bus if it's not a necessity. Not knowing details that change the projectory for a large family, sole head of household, single parent can be extremely frustrating for myself and the children in your school. I asked at the beginning of school about the scholarship program. I was told they didn't have the forms yet. Was never contacted back by email or phone call. I was not contacted about payment for the sport. But the student was told the day before the first game that he could not play since he did not pay. Where is that information located for the responsible adult, that drives and pays for these activities? The communication in this area is awful in my opinion and that is affecting your student athlete who wants to participate in every single season sport, because I am so frustrated with the lack of communication and not knowing how to plan for ALL my children/your students. This is our only experience with high school so far. COVID and this year. I think the overall experience seems to teach the student to be responsible for their actions, needs and requirements. But they are still young adults and when they participate in school led sports activities MY CHILD your STUDENT is not expected to work while attend school/tutoring/homework and practice/game days. It would be a huge support to this family to have a site or general communication for the responsible parent of the student in your care.

I'm please with all the staff, they are very professional concerning the welfare of the students.

In general, I feel that communication at Roskrige (MS) is very poor and that parents don't feel

welcome or invited to be a part of their child's education. Back to School night was uninspiring, communication is poor, and my child feel they have no one to turn to at school. It would be beneficial to have an Advisory period or some other form for students to form relationships with adults other than typical class time. Middle school is hard enough without feeling isolated and overwhelmed by school structures. Roskruge should do much more to build community, connect with families, and communicate about academics.

It would be nice if the open house events would start at 7 instead of 6.

My children love their school.

My daughter is very independent and rarely needs my assistance. She seems to have a good relationship with her teachers and enjoys her Science class with Mr. White.

My daughter was sexually assaulted at is assaulted at the school and administration chose to do nothing about it. There is one teacher that constantly harasses her. The vice principle is a complete joke. She does not have control over her school and she does not take appropriate action or give appropriate consequences.

My high schooler's teachers communicate and offer support independently from the school and with varied levels of success and consistency. That influences my answers here, which I tried to provide based on the overall impression I have. Also, I am operationalizing a parent-teacher conference as a one-on-one meeting with my student's teacher(s), which has not been offered. We have attended open houses and such, but these do not serve the same purpose as conferences.

My only input is that when a child gets hurt even something minor, that the parent is notified.

My son has IEP and requested twice for a meeting with counselor. No response. No additional aid for my child to assist in classroom. No resource teacher or counselor available to my child when needed. Very disappointed in Mansfelds resources for children with an IEP

My son was sent home for covid exposure. We were told that all of his work would be on teams. It was not and only one teacher responded to the individual emails that I sent,. As a result he is behind still and trying to get caught up.

My sons teacher goes way above and beyond and expectations I could of had.

My student is not receiving homework (besides nightly reading. Next year, she will be in 5th and will be expected to do homework in preparation for middle school. I am concerned that with no homework this school year, she will struggle next year to meet expectations set by the fifth grade team.

Myers is a phenomenal school with a phenomenal staff! They treat my children like family and not like a number!

Principal not as accessible to students on campus- my children have not personally felt she is warm and approachable, but have had great teachers, few not so great during the pandemic. Overall a great school with great teachers. Principal should know more of her student body an make an effort to say hello and know more students by name and be more approachable.

Problems w/ the girls bathrooms persist - there is a need for additional female monitors to stop the bullying and drug use and to help girls who are having their periods not get pushed or cut in line; hence making them late to class. Teacher's response to this problem has improved. But girls on their period should have a bathroom available to actually use when they need it. As an aside, this survey is not designed in way to get the most and best info from respondents, Very little actionable data can be reaped from this survey. (This is often the issue with most TUSD surveys, unfortunately.)
