
#### Abstract

As part of its Annual Report, the District shall provide a report of student participation in a sampling of extracurricular activities at each school. The activities that are reported each year shall include at least two activities from each of the four categories described in section (B) above: sports at schools at which they are offered, social clubs, student publications (where offered) and co-curricular activities. The data in the report shall include District-wide data and data by school, disaggregated by race, ethnicity and ELL status. The Parties shall have the right to request additional data or information if the Annual Report indicates disparities or concerns. USP Section VIII.C(1)

## Mojave Recommendation

This is an excellent opportunity to design architecture for a semi self-contained interscholastic module which has the components to integrate with future Student Management software choices of TUSD. Short term, the existing High School Interscholastic module can be modified to accommodate new requirements for High School. Elementary and Middle schools can be implemented on the new structures with the potential for integrating High School at a later time.

Timeframe would be based on implementation decisions.

Starting in March, the Extracurricular activities portion of Project 7 began to work on setting up a plan for equitable access to Extracurricular activities for all students. One of the things that were need first of all was to make the necessary changes to Mojave, our reporting system and data collection system to include middle schools and elementary schools. We also needed the module for the high schools to be adjusted to include all extracurricular activities and not just interscholastics, which is the current system.

An initial meeting was set up with Karen Jones and her staff in Technology Services on March 12, 2013. In this meeting a plan was devise to make changes to Mojave and subsequent meetings were set up. Two other meetings occurred in April 26, 2013 and May 17, 2013 to review the progress and make any necessary changes to the module.

Since this is the first year that Extracurricular activities is included in the plan, we did not collect any data regarding equal access. Also, we were unable to monitor or set up any transportation services as the school year was winding down and we had only met once to discuss transportation for the Unitary Status Plan with Project 3. Those meeting and services will be a part of our 2013-2014 annual report.
