



Re: Summary of the November Monthly Color-Coded Report

The African American Student Services (AASSD), Student Success Specialists (SSS) documented 3,491 contacts for the month of November. The documented contacts are 1,296 less contacts than the month of October. Possible reasons for the decline may be a result of our staff development addressing appropriate documentation of student contacts and interactions, and the number of sick days documented during the month of November. This month we noticed greater emphasis on classroom support at the elementary level and the collaboration with our mentor partnerships (U of A Project Soar and National Society of Black Engineers group).

The following charts and graphs provide a pictorial perspective of support provided using the 4pronged approach (the A, B, C's of what we do).






