OELAS Extension/ELL Progress (2014-15)

On December 8, 2014, the Arizona State Board of Education approved optional refinements to the Arizona Structured English Immersion Models, specifically to the four hour ELD block K-12. The refinements were designed for implementation beginning with the 2015-16 school year. Because of the Board decision, the Arizona Department of Education Office of English Language Acquisition Services (OELAS) extension was not pursued (see attached *Approved Refinements to the SEI Models*). Instead, the District continued with the Four-Hour Model of English Language Development (ELD) instruction that was utilized the prior year. The key component of this model was Individual Language Learner Plans (ILLPs). ILLPs are implemented when:

- 1. ELL populations were less than twenty students among a three grade band level;
- 2. All subjects [except for foreign language] were taught in English;
- 3. Instruction consisted of English Language Development [ELD];
- 4. Math, science, and social studies provided to students through sheltered instructional strategies, which are techniques used to make concepts understandable to all students

Students that participated in the ELD program were PHLOTE students-(Primary Home Language Other Than English) identified as second language learners on the Home Language Survey. The students take the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA) placement test, and the students' proficiency scores determined appropriate placement for instruction. AZELLA was a standards-based assessment that met both state and federal requirements to measure students' English language proficiency. Students placed into an English language learner program take the AZELLA reassessment once per year until they achieve proficiency and are reclassified. Students gained proficiency with a passing score of the three sub-tests - Reading, Writing, and Oral Fluency.

All sites had a Four-Hour ELD Model and/or an ILLP program to serve their English Language Learners. For the SY 2014-15, a total of 4,671 ELL students across the District were served. In 2015, the District tested 3,878 students for English language proficiency with the AZELLA. Of those students, 1,005 students (or 26%) were reclassified from an English Language Learner (ELL) to English proficiency status.

To change their status, students were required to achieve a proficient score on all three AZELLA subtests: Reading, Writing, and Oral. In the last three years combined, 11,697 students were assessed. Of those students, 2,932 students were reclassified as being English proficient, which correlates to a 25% reclassification rate.

This data indicates that the District consistently reclassifies about 25% of ELLs each year.

The average number of years to become reclassified from ELL/ELLAR to English proficiency is 2.85 years. Targeted instruction, a dedicated teaching core, and best instructional practice for our ELL students were responsible for the District's English proficiency success in such a short time period. According to research by Hakuta at the University of California, (Hakuta, 2000, http://escholarship.org/uc/item/13w7m06g), oral proficiency in English takes three to five years, on average, to develop. Moreover, academic English proficiency takes even longer at four to seven years to develop.

The former Director of Language Acquisition, Dr. Ignacio Ruiz, was in the process of submitting a request to OELAS to be granted for an extension to be implemented in SY 15-16. However, Dr. Ruiz withdrew his proposal because the Arizona Department of Education (ADE) released the new approved optional refinements to the Arizona Structured English Immersion Models on December 8, 2014 (see attached *OELAS Extension Memo 5.13.15*).

ADE granted the District permission to implement the Phoenix Union Model for the Writing period. The Phoenix Union Alternate SEI Model incorporated content materials in either science or social studies during the reading period of the four-hour ELD requirement. Phoenix Union implemented this model for secondary students who scored an 'Overall Intermediate' on the AZELLA. The ELD teachers participating in the model were required to be highly qualified in English and well as in the Science or Social Studies content area that they were teaching. This model was implemented at Catalina Magnet HS during the 2014-15 school year. See the table for a list of classes.

The District planned to use the Phoenix Union model at Doolen and Valencia Middle Schools beginning in the spring semester 2015. The plan was put on hold because ADE was moving forward in the fall of 2014 to modify the Four-Hour ELD Model, which would eliminate the need for the Phoenix Union Model. The ADE-approved refinements allowed secondary intermediate level students to schedule only two periods of ELD instead of four. The District plans to expand the refinements to the secondary level at schools practicing the Four-Hour ELD Model in SY 15-16.

The OELAS Expansion plan was no longer relevant because of approved refinements. These approved refinements were flexible and allowed elementary and self-contained middle schools to provide instruction to first year ELL students, and to all ELL students below the intermediate proficiency level. The instruction consisted of two "blocks", totaling four hours. The first block included 120 minutes of integrated reading, oral English conversation, and vocabulary. The second block included 120 minutes of integrated writing and grammar. Instruction options also included up to 30 minutes of literacy intervention services with non-ELL students that counted towards the four hour requirement.

Refinements also allowed the elementary and middle schools to integrate required instructional domains and reduce the time required within the SEI Models. This refinement applied to ELL students who demonstrated overall proficiency at the intermediate level measured by the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA) for up to an hour. These students were required to be at least in their second year of English language development (ELD) instruction. Lastly, when a flexible plan was appropriate for an ELL student, teachers delivered ELD instruction using ELP standards during two "blocks", totaling three hours. Block one consisted of 90 minutes of integrated writing and grammar and block two included minutes of integrated reading, oral English conversation and vocabulary.

The approved refinements also allowed the secondary level to provide an option for ELD teacher(s) and/or ELL Coordinators to reduce the time required within the four hour ELD block for ELL students (up to 2 hours) who demonstrated overall proficiency at the intermediate level on the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA), and were enrolled in at least their second year of English Language Development (ELD) instruction

The District administered four trainings for teachers to learn more about the approved refinements (see *ELD Teacher Refinement-Workshop Attendance; SEI Refinements 4_28_15; SEI Refinements 5_5_15; SEI Refinements 5_11_15; SEI Refinement Workshop 14-15*). Additionally, in Summer 2015, the Language Acquisition Department trained staff on the ADE's new ELD refinement models. Staff

members conducted trainings on June 8-11 during the Summer Literacy Institute and over 100 ELD teachers attended (see attached *Summer Lit4DayRoster*).

The training objectives were for staff members to learn the ELD/SEI model refinements, learn the new ELD curriculum documents for TUSD, be able to incorporate cooperative learning strategies to facilitate content learning, and design a product that reflected their new training. The full-week workshop included how to fully implement the SEI Refinement Model. Teachers were given their PHLOTE lists and were asked to organize their plans, schedules, and instruction to meet the model's requirement at their school sites.

Low incidence schools are still required to maintain the Individual Language Learner Plan (ILLP) process for the required 2 hours.





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

SUBJECT: OELAS Extension

OELAS extension will not be further pursued.

OELAS extension will no longer be recommended to pursue, due to the Arizona State Board of Education approving refinements to the 4 – Hour ELD block K-12. These refinements will allow flexibility within the 4-Hour ELD block that will no longer require us to pursue the OELAS extension. The following flexibility will be allowed:

A. Elementary and self-contained middle schools flexibility to provide the following services to <u>first</u> <u>year ELLs</u> and all <u>ELLs below</u> the intermediate proficiency level:

- 1. ELD instruction using the English Language Proficiency (ELP) standards during two "blocks", totaling 4 hours:
 - a. Block 1: 120 minutes of integrated reading, oral English conversation and vocabulary
 - b. Block 2: 120 minutes of integrated writing and grammar
- c. Up to 30 minutes of literacy intervention services with non-ELLs that may count towards the 4-hour requirement if those services meet the instructional needs of the ELL student.
- B. Allow elementary and self-contained middle schools flexibility to integrate required instructional domains and reduce, up to 1 hour, the time required within the SEI Models for ELLs who demonstrate overall proficiency at the intermediate level on the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA). Are in at least their 2nd year of English language development (ELD) instruction)
- 1. For those ELLs for whom flexibility is appropriate, ELD instruction using ELP standards may be delivered during two "blocks", totaling 3 hours:
 - a. Block 1: 90 minutes of integrated writing and grammar
 - b. Block 2: 90 minutes of integrated reading, oral English conversation and vocabulary

Secondary Refinements are the following:

Provide an option for ELD (English Language Development) teacher(s) and / or ELL Coordinators to **reduce**, up to 2 hours, the time required within the 4-Hour ELD block for ELLs who:

- Demonstrate overall proficiency at the intermediate level on the Arizona English Language Learner Assessment (AZELLA), and
- Are in at least their 2nd year of English language development (ELD) instruction.
