An example on the 6-12 Student Survey of a negatively worded question is: "School work in this class is too easy". If a teacher receives a score of 1.5 (after reverse scoring), the results indicate that the students strongly agreed with the question and the class is not challenging. If a teacher receives a 3.5, the results indicate that the students disagreed with the question and the class is challenging.
