We have \$10,000 in the ALE budget that was slated to support students taking AP exams by providing them scholarships to pay for the AP testing. Below is the plan for how we intend to proceed:

The normal fee for an AP exam is \$92

If a student qualifies for free/reduced lunch they pay a reduced amount of \$20 per exam

We would like to scholarship any student who qualifies for free/reduced lunch and who is taking multiple exams by having exams beyond the first, paid for through a scholarship. (student pays the first \$20 exam fee, we pay for exams after that)

We would like to scholarship any African American or Latino students who do not qualify for free/reduced lunch by having exams beyond the first, paid for through a scholarship. (student pays the first \$92 exam fee, we pay for exams after that)

Sites may be able to use other funds (PTA, Tax credit, etc) to supplement these scholarships, by providing them to other students who would not qualify with the above criteria or for students who do qualify as above but for whom we don't have enough funding to cover.

We would give each site the requirements above to use and would also provide a set amount of scholarship funding per site.
