GSRR Violation Levels and Possible Actions

When considering actions, the District strives to implement Restorative Practices and to keep student in their classrooms whenever possible. Additionally, teachers and administrators must ensure that they follow the MTSS process at all times. Disciplinary actions must be non-discriminatory, fair, age-appropriate, and correspond to the severity of the student's misbehavior. For all violations, parent notification and a student conference are mandatory.
