Some teachers are in need of additional profession support outside of what is provided routinely to all teachers new to the District and the profession. Accordingly, the District has developed and implements a Teacher Support Plan designed to assist underperforming and struggling teachers. The Teacher Support Plan outlines a program for all teachers within the District regardless of their length of service. The District refers teachers to the program who are identified as performing inadequately in the classroom (underperforming) or needing support (struggling).
