### **Key online transactional systems and data sets (EBAS Systems for USP)**

The following provides a summary of the key online transactional systems and data sets serving as EBAS source data as of school year 2018-19. Additions in 2018-19 include a tracking system for family engagement events developed in-house at TUSD. In 2019-20, the District is replacing the current student intervention system, Clarity, with a module of Synergy, the core student information system for the District. The District integrates data from these systems as needed to conduct analyses and assessments of academic outcomes and strategies, and to correlate with teacher and student assessment data.
