Summary of Lottery Results in Oversubscribed Schools

RC = Racially Concentrated,

The above data is for the dates from October 2018 to July 2019 for student placements in the 2019-2020 school year. There are less oversubscribed schools this year than in the past because the District had an objective to place every student in the program they applied for and we worked with the sites to accommodate those students to the extent possible.

Target seats are those for the lottery only; they do not include placements such as GATE, pipeline etc. These are subtracted from the overall targets so the lottery placements will help to achieve the overall targets. Target seats may be higher than placements because other placements were made, such as siblings or exceptional education students, after the targets were prepared.

The lottery placements matched targets to the extent possible given the applicant pools. The applicant pools for McCorkle and Roskruge are predominately composed of Hispanic students to the extent that is it not possible to achieve integration at those schools.
