Re: Schedule for DAR and SMAR

This memo confirms schedule for submission of the DAR, SMAR and Petitions for Unitary Status. Again.

October 1. The district will submit its indication of the extent to which it has meant the obligations with respect to each of the provisions of the USP and related action plans.

No later than October 31, the plaintiffs will submit any objections they may have to the DAR. This does not limit the plaintiffs' rights to submit objections to any district proposals with respect to unitary status for all or parts of the USP that may be forthcoming.

No later than November 30, I will submit my annual report which will include recommendations with respect to whether the district should receive relief from court supervision on any or all of the provisions of the USP.

During the first week in December, the parties will meet with respect to the 2019 budget and discuss whether there is agreement that the district should be relieved the court supervision on any or all of the provisions of the USP.

No later than December 15, the Special Master will submit the final version of the 2016-17 SMAR with

recommendations to the court with respect to whether the district should receive unitary status on any or all of the provisions of the USP.

On a date to be specified, the district will submit its proposal to the court with respect to any or all provisions of the USP that the district believes should be awarded unitary status.
