In SY2022-23 the District continued to utilize a revised Early Warning System (EWS) through the MTSS modules in Synergy –the district's Student Information System (SIS). In its second year of implementation, the MTSS EWS identifies students' risk levels (high, moderate, low) with respect to a variety of indicators including attendance, grades, behavior, and graduation credits. At the K-5 level, users can identify students at high risk with respect to academic content areas. At the middle and high school level, risk scores are calculated for each indicator, and an overall risk score is calculated by averaging risk scores for grades, attendance, and behavior. Accumulated high school credits for graduation are also available for 9th-12th grade students.

Staff can utilize the MTSS EWS system to identify students who need additional academic, behavioral or attendance support and can create student plans accordingly.

In November 2022, the District created an MTSS committee to ensure that MTSS continued to be utilized with fidelity at all school sites. The committee identified and assessed the needs at each site, and developed an action plan that will guide the work in the 2023-24 school year.
