Parents may enroll in magnet and application schools <u>directly online</u> once an offer acceptance letter is received.

- 1. A separate application is required for each student.
- 2. All mailings are time sensitive. Parents/guardians must notify the school to update a change of address in their student's record.
- 3. Magnet schools/programs are subject to modification. Affected parents/guardians will be informed immediately if this occurs.
- 4. Free transportation is available for in-District magnet students, qualified open enrollment students (see <u>tusd1.org/schoolchoice</u>), and neighborhood students living more than 1.5 miles away (for elementary & K8 schools) or 2.5 miles away (for middle & high schools).
