tucson high has barely any engagement with parents. parents don't feel supported or that the administration wants us to engage or be involved. it's a shame. tvis used to be a good school.

There are no textbooks. My child would benefit from textbooks.

Coming from Rincon, Sahuaro is a night and say diffence. All together much more professional and welcoming from every single person I have encountered. Sally the school nurse even called after the weekend to make sure my kid was doing well!

My son still does not have a textbook for his AP Environmental Science class. Many students also started the year without a working computer. This seems to be more of a district level issue.

For parents new to Saguaro (freshman or new to school) better orientation about how homework, assignments are communicated to the kids. Status of temporary teachers such as 11th grade English. Our student is an exchange student. She asked the counselor if she could meet the other exchange student and she never replied. By chance, they finally met. I feel like this school is so big, kids are only #s. Everyone is too busy to do the small things that sometimes make the most difference.

All staff at Bloom, especially my dtrs teacher, Ms. Haney, have been excellent. I wish people in Tucson would vote to support schools because Bloom lacks so much in the way of infrastructure- the field is awful, there is NO gym space to do PE when it's hot and insufficient shade outside. Teachers are underpaid while administration, specifically Mr. Trujillo, is paid a base salary of \$230k, a 14!!! % increase, asking with other perks. When is the last time teachers got a 14% increase? This is short sighted and greedy. Perhaps administration could forgo their pay raises and give that \$ to the teachers instead.

Sahuaro has been an amazing school.

We did not have an English teacher several weeks into 1st qt

There seems to be very little happening outside of the principal newsletter. The PTA is led by someone who doesn't even have a child here. Emails I've sent to the principal and admins have never been responded to. Unsure if this is because they are overwhelmed and under-resourced by TUSD or simply disinterested.

Not satisfied with the principal. She is not communicative and allowed my child to be bullied and physically assaulted. She does not have a good reputation among parents and the community.

I wish the principal of Secrist Middle Scho would respond to contact attempts. I have had several attempts to contact her go without any response or follow up. The office staff and academic interventionist are both very communicative and easy to get a hold of.

There needs to be better communication as far as joining pta and school activities.

We love Robinson elementary and the staff and principal is amazing here!

I would love the opportunity to be more involved in my child's school. The opportunities are just not there.

We had a situation with another student. We did not intend for the student to get into trouble and would have much rather heard the child and family received counseling and resources to help the child.

There are several spots within your survey that you could add other and comment section. For question 22, I chose other because the main barrier is the autonomous teaching styles and lack of rigor through not assigning homework. I am a product of TUSD and my experience was always having homework. With the Covid gap, it's a surprise we don't have more rigor or daily reading logs or daily math facts or daily anything. Kids are not encouraged to learn and teachers lean too much on digital programs to teach instead of old school paper pencil discovery learning. "Involve me, and I will learn" have a child do IXL, Apex and I ready as their only way to teach does not benefit the child.

Autonomous teaching destroy the learning for children. Montessori is supposed to be different. I was disappointed to observe the lack of Montessori style by the teacher. The principal is amazing! Dr. Celaya is wonderful, but autonomous teaching takes away from the Montessori model.

It has come to my attention that there is a sprouting racism in my school community. Also, the parents are showing pride in a negative way that is resulting into their kids bullying other kids. I wish that the school can promote awareness against bullying and for teachers to remind parents that they should behave properly in front of their children because it is not good for children to be seeing and hearing poor social attitude from the adults. An example is that some guardians who pick up their children smell like marijiuana, and it is very uncomfortable because a lot of adults and children can smell it too. I don't think that should be normalized because the school is an institution for children to be learning, and not a place for adults to be parading improper things like that. Parents were given less than one week's notice to attend a mandatory in-person meeting about the trip (which is nearly 2 years from now). I continue to have to scramble to figure out how to participate or have my child participate in these meetings/events with little notice. Thus, much further lead time for these things would be great.

We are lucky there is Higher Grounds at Doolen. Otherwise, I would not be aware of many things. The only thing I wish this school would do better at is notifying me when something serious happens at school with my child. I've had to deal with my son getting hurt by another student and not finding out until I picked him up from school and him being really hurt. Also the principal not answering or returning my concerns. Communication from office and disciplinary action could be better.

For kindergarten, my child complains that school is boring and that she hates school when before she loved school. My child is very active and I had made a suggestion to the teacher about doing interactive learning to engage the child and promote the want to learn with fun. Not sure if my suggestion was offensive to the teacher. I just want to see my child succeed and enjoy going to school like before.

My child's teacher does not provide the level of teaching that I have come to expect. To date, my child has received homework only 3-4 times the entire semester. In addition, the homework that was completed is not marked and returned to the student. Nor are the problems/questions reviewed in class so that the student has the opportunity to learn from their mistakes. In addition, worksheets that are done in class are never reviewed or given back to the students. Students receive no test preparation for any district or State tests. Often times the student is unaware there is a test until the same day of the test. Proper notification should be provided to students so they can adequately prepare/practice for their tests. Ideally, test dates should be established and provided to parents at the beginning of each semester. Sewell received a new principle this year. Overall Ms. Gow has done a good job governing and guiding the school. However, she has made changes that have left the kids upset. She has removed the opportunity for the kids to go outside for a 10:30am break - students must now remain in the class for the break and talk quietly.

I am currently VERY unhappy with my childs teacher. I am unhappy that her 504 plan is not being followed as well as being placed in a behavioral plan without myself, her therapist who works with the school, or even my child being informed!

We emailed the principal and the counselor and did not receive a response either time from either individual.

The ticket said it would be over at 11:30pm but at 11:15pm all the students were told to leave and my daughter was out in the dark for 15 mins!! This school DOES NOT relay events well but they make sure you get a stupid survey to fill out!!!

I would love it if we had a "Meet the Teacher" where we could just chat about what's going on at the school. I attended the Open House at the beginning of the school year but only had a few minutes in each class and didn't learn much about what my child is studying. Since she's getting good grades we weren't able to have a conference because those are reserved for students/families with concerns. I know it's high school, but it would be nice to feel more like part of the community as a parent. I am hoping as I serve on the UHSPA I'll start to feel more a part of the school because right now, I'm just a taxi for my child.

So long as my child is protected from perversions I will fully support my child's school.

Food boxes and other resources have been very helpful. Thank you Jannette Gastélum for making these resources accessible.

The principal, Mr. Van Schie does an excellent job in being friendly, approachable and communicative. The staff, in general doesn't necessarily follow suit. I have heard that teachers/staff were taking Monday/Friday training days off. If that is the case - That is a staff discipline/dedication problem that should be addressed, but not at the expense/not become the problem of families. Tie attendance at those required sessions to bonuses/pay incentives.

I do not feel that there was enough time or chance to sign up for conferences. I also feel that the one and only evening opportunity was not enough. I work as a teacher on the west side of town and my husband travels for work. During the conference week there wasn't enough time to make it.

The engagement level really varies from teacher to teacher; not so much by school. Some teachers are amazingly fantastic and others not so much. For some of the teachers I even wonder what they are trying to teach my child. I am aware though that finding amazingly fantastic teachers is challenging and hence I fully appreciate those that are.

My frustration about teacher conferences is that the TUSD schedule listed Friday Sep22 as the conference day for 9-12 (and it is stil listed as those dates) but yet both UHS and THMS offered conferences on Thursday afternoon/evening. One of my children had a swim meet at CDO and we live on the west side so my choice was either go to the meet to cheer on my child or go to a conference. I can't understand why TUSD would publish a schedule and then allow schools not to follow it. Tusd needs to train people to let go of toxic behaviors just because you're in a position of authority.

I would like my child's teacher to communicate more regularly with updates regarding his learning strategies after the 1st parent-teacher conference to ensure that my child is learning at an appropriate level based on the results from his assessments discussed at the 1st parent-teacher conference or discuss way to help his learn at the appropriate level.

When it says "the staff" or "school" I'm really answering based just on the teacher. Mr Manjarre is amazing, dedicated to my child's success, and keeps me very well informed as well as offers guidance and support as well as he is open to hearing my suggestions to help my child succeed.

Bonillas is a wonderful school that has a great community we're proud to be part of! Time is not being used by the school in a way that aligns with state and national laws. Children are not given proper instruction nor does the staff re teach subjects over the year. We have over 39 free days in English with not one essay completed. I've had to fight to get teachers to follow the law. The teacher conference was BEFORE the benchmark tests. Benchmark tests were not aligned by state standards. Children can't speak English in class and sit in tablet watching YouTube instead of getting help. Creating a culture that respects math and language arts makes learning at home after school a lot easier for parents. Rubrics given are not used by teachers. Low quality instructions and low expectations lead to problems at home and society as a whole, that's not internalized by the school as externalities, so it can't be managed. Teacher unions have an illegal Stakeholder position that harms teacher culture that trickles down to students. It's not babysitting, it's supposed to be a school from 9am to 4 pm. Lots of blame on households when the staff flat out refuses to actually teach and have children practice in class from 9-4. Overall the system is set up to fail 1/4 to 3/4 of the students. They like talking about sex with the students - not writing essays, yet don't want to parent everyone's child? Despite the Contradiction and hypocrisy of the principal and staff, my child would still attend the school. What choice does she have? They're all like this, too comfy for too long doing diabolical things while maintaining a good reputation based on being a teacher that can't get fired is the problem. The school advertising one thing, but they're doing another. I feel like there are none negative consequences for misbehaving students and it is getting out of control. Students need to understand what is expected of them and that otherwise they would have a negative consequence which doesn't happen in this school.

The conference periods on Tuesday and Thursday leave too much unsupervised time for students. It's becoming a safety issue.
