After completing health screenings, each participant receives health education focused on their needs and their interests. If participants do not have medical insurance or a defined primary doctor, and their results are out of range, they are referred to a Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC). Subsequently, if the participant agrees, a follow-up call is completed after one month and/or 3 months to see if they have received medical guidance. We also can provide Narcan kits and educational baggies. The educational baggies include brochures about several health topics. During our events we invite people to follow us on Facebook and Instagram. In our social media we deliver 'Charlas' on different health topics; we also generate posts focused on health, prevention, and well-being.
