Attendance at the school has been a problem. The teachers seem to make mark my child absent when they are activities at school, and the attends office does not seem to understand.

Last year (23-24) and this year (24-25) I have noticed grades for assignments/tests are not inputted into Parent Vue regularly. Last year my child's assignment grades were only imputed at the end of each semester and this year no assignments grades have been entered into Parent Vue at all (only report card entered), this is making it extremely difficult to keep up with my child's progress in school and see where I, as the parent, can help before the end of the semester. For years prior to the 2023-2024 school year at Robins all assignments were entered into Parent Vue either daily or weekly; however, last year and this year has been different. No graded paperwork is returning home with students, no test results entered in Parent Vue for parents to view and I find it odd because I know the students have weekly tests. I have reached out to my child's teacher this year to check on my child's progress and have yet to receive a response. I want to make note that I am requesting that this survey response remain confidential and that there is no retaliation in any way, shape or form against my child at school by their teacher or any other staff member at Robins K8.

And he needs to stop, that I am being manipulated by my son. I got the feeling that the chair person would like to remove my son's IEP completely as she does not believe he needs any help. The chair of EXED told me to never talk to her again. So I have complied. I will never talk to her again. I know he needs help because I received his IEP and believe it was the benchmark test score he is not even achieving middle school scores in anything but everyone says he is just not trying. So in two years he will graduate and will not be at the learning level of a 9th grader. Boy that sounds like a success.

Communication from the teachers

Communication is very limited and often last minute. Such as "wear blue tomorrow" or when things are happening. I know there are clubs and groups but I've only found out about them through the grapevine, other parents etc, instead of actually being offered things through the school.

I do receive the emails from TUSD for Family Resource centers but not directly through our elementary school

I don't agree with the overwhelming amount of homework. Especially for children who need a lot of help and aren't where their peers are but don't have an iep. Pushing more work on them only makes them resent and stray away from at school learning and prevents the household from doing things outside of school related to sports, church, we only get our kids 5 hours after school for a decent bedtime and still get everything done. Homework becomes unenjoyable

I don't help regularly with homework but I do ensure that homework or unfinished work assignments are being completed.

I don't know if our child will be successful at THMS, but the school has put support systems in place to help her - it's a matter of her not being motivated enough to accept the help at this time.

I feel like more information should be in the website. Having to look through the newsletters for the information that is needed is too much sometimes only appearing in one newsletter so you have to look through them all.

I feel like we have almost zero information about the school (policies, clubs, etc).

I feel that Mr. Brock and Mr. Levato only handle certain situations I think it is appalling at the fact that girls show up at this school half dressed literally but want to dress code my son for wearing a tank top, get out of here with that. You have high school kids selling and bringing drugs to school on the daily and yet they are more worried about boys wearing tank tops. My 17 year old senior was threatened with a gun and yet nothing was done to the student besides a 3 day ISS I promise TUSD that if anything happens to either one of my children while on school grounds because of this threat then I will hold the school and the school board solely responsible as they were made aware of the situation

and did absolutely nothing.

I feel that my child is spending too much time on the computer at school.

I have a 4th and 7th grader Maxwell is awesome the teachers the principal is the best I've seen she really cares and it shows!!

I have been able to know what my child 's grades and attendance look like from the Parent view app only. When I email or call his school or teachers I do not get responses.

I have concerns with the teachers who complain openly to the students about their pay and work expectations. There is at least one every year who trauma dumps on children about how miserable their job is. This misery is often paired with a refusal to read email on the weekend or stay after school because that is not contract time. I came into TUSD as a bleeding heart convinced that sending my children to public school was the right thing to do to ensure robust public support for public education. I grew up in Mississippi, and Tucson public schools have left me in shock and awe at the way children are let down and left behind as a matter of routine. Sending my kids to TUSD schools may have been my biggest parenting failure.

I have never seen a person so determined to limit opportunities for young students. He is disrespectful to the parents, teachers and students. He sets a bad example for everyone in the school. I would gladly elaborate. This is a bad apple in a good school.

Despite this, I find that my child has met most teachers in his even ones outside his grade level and due to this interaction it seems to makes him more excited about the coming years of school, the teachers that I have directly worked with have all been accommodating, considerate and willing to work with me and my child is meeting their needs in the classroom and giving handouts with extra advice for parents on how to motivate/aid their children meet the expectations of the classroom and the duties that come with becoming an active learner in their education.

I REACHED OUT TO MY CHILDS TEACHER AFTER RECEIVING THE REPORT CARD FOR Q1, REQUESTING TUTORING INFORMATION AND DID NOT HEAR BACK. I THEN CALLED THE FRONT DESK AND ASKED ABOUT THE PROCESS TO GET MY CHILD STARTED IN TUTORING AND WAS REDIRECTED BACK TO THE

TEACHER WHO I SENT ANOTHER MESSAGE TO AND STILL HAVE YET TO HEAR BACK. I AM FINE BEING PATIENT BUT DO FEEL MY CHILD IS BEING LEFT BEHIND DESPITE MY EFFORTS TO KEEP HER ON TRACK.

I really appreciated the community effort and the overall unity I saw come together for the fall festival. It was so great to see the kids all having a great time!

I thank the school and the teachers for helping my child he's improving a lot in his in English speaking and he is now easily communicating and he's doing good in different courses therefore. I would recommend the teachers to continue providing, supporting and helping my child to do better in his studies.

I think that the principal (Ms. Montoya) shouldn't be principal ! She is very rude to myself as a parent of a student whom attends Gridley Middle School. She is unable to stay organized with students whom had been in situations during class. Involved with bullying/ sexual harassment from another student. The teacher at the time also mad very inappropriate comments to my child in the classroom, and also to myself over the phone. I didn't feel comfortable with the comments or think it was even necessary from them to be made. Yet nothing was done about it. It also seems nothing is going to be done about it. When I spoke with her she couldn't remember even talking with myself multiple times about the situation. I put my trust in the school for my child to be safe and feel safe at school, unfortunately I'm not as comfortable as I should be with Gridley Middle School because of the principal (Ms. Montoya) not doing her job or taking her duties seriously. I as a parent refuse to speak with her about anything anymore because that's how bad it is with her!

I think the innovative ways the school is looking to support our kids is so great for their emotional and physical and social and academic development. Thinking specifically about programs at Sabino like Pencils and Pancakes which provides a place for kids to get extra help/homework time, but makes it feel more like a morning around the breakfast table with your friends and family. Such a great "outside the box" approaches to education really help the kids get connected to their learning in a deeper way.

I think they're should be a better way to communicate with different staff members and follow up/return calls. Also I think it would be beneficial if the teachers communicated homework instructions. Ways of teaching have changed and if the teachers are teaching it one way and the parents another, it gets very frustrating for all parties involved. Thank you.

I understand the homework policy at Borton but in my opinion it doesn't help prepare students for middle school to build that habit. Also the school has improved on communication but the school as a whole seems so disconnected and if you are a parent that can't come inside the school regularly you miss out on a lot of things. There's a community feeling that's missing

I want to petition for a new principal

I was told that any family member can volunteer at the school. I went to volunteer and someone came to the classroom questioning why I was there. I am a grandma of two children that goes to the school have always been a big part of there schooling and medical. My daughter is a single mom and works . She can't always get to the school. So I'm a big part of my grandchildrens education. But was told that I could not attend there conference. Even with my daughter giving them permission. I can take my grandchildren to the doctors appointments with no issues. I feel if a parent gives permission then the school district should be happy someone can be a big part in the education of the children.

I will always make time for my child education it's my number one priority. And the school she attends is amazing!

I wish I could receive information about school events sooner than a few days before.

I wish schools would do more about bullying and all the fights at my child's school

I wish some of the classes offered to parents were remote as an option. I would love to attend some of the resource center classes but they are a commute and often times I won't have childcare. I would love it if there was a parent spanish class so we could learn alongside our kids.

I wish the district would support my child's kindergarten, there is a severely autistic student in class and he needs more intervention that I believe should come from the crisis support staff or admin outside of our school.

I wish the school really helped kids when they are sick and can't be at school to reach out to the kids and make sure they know which assignments they need and give them detailed notes more so and helped with making sure they get them done. Everything needs to be explained and given to them. Bell works, class assignments, quizzes and tests should be available

I work 12 hours a day

I work an 8am to 5pm, Monday through Friday and also have 2 other evening jobs. This makes it difficult to get into the classroom or school. I have made it too and volunteered for evening events.

I would appreciate more effort from teachers in providing progress in academics and not letting students "fall through the cracks". Even if it is ensuring parents see the report cards to address concerns before it's too late

I would like to have more informative parent teacher conferences.

I would like to know more about how I can help the teacher educate my grandson. Tutoring? Additional after school help? Homework help on Tuesday and Thursday is fantastic, thank you.

I'm happy with the school's academic and staff

I'm so happy with my child's school , staff and administration! They're always on top of everything they respond to questions concerns in such a timely manner.

I've asked several times to hire a crossing guard or at least put the cross walk signs out but they refused and locked them up. Now me and my child along with other students are having to run through traffic just to get to school. I discussed this with principal Mac and school safety district. Both shut me down and refused to leave signs out to cross walk

I'd like more guidance from the school regarding how they can help support my child with his ADHD IEP guidelines not followed for end of 1st quarter of progress report sent home. Lack communication of those involved in the IEP team through out the year. 21st century program excludes my child from participating in student council. Not sure child will return for next school year

I'm very pleased with the quality of education and sound administration that Sabino High School has provided 3 of my children so far.

It is hard for me to support the wonderful opportunities available (field trip costs; pictures; t-shirts; donations) because I struggle financially. But I am working on it.

It would be great if we could find a free, secure (meaning not gathering data about our kids) communication tool to replace Class Dojo.

It would be nice if we could somehow add psat and the other similar tests to parent view.... Or if it's there already an explanation on how to find it.

It would be nice to have a facilitated parent support group with a counselor. The students are going through really challenging stuff and as a parent I have no clue how to help my kid. I feel like the teachers and principals have made responding to their oversight of notifications my third job.

My child is behind in his reading level. The teachers have been telling us this in 2nd and 3rd grade. The teachers make their best effort to help catch him up but I really think a reading specialist is needed at the school to work in small groups or one on one. I believe a Davis had a reading specialist in the past. An after school tutoring session and after school homework helper would be amazing!

My child is being bullied in this school and they are not addressing it. The teachers tell my child to stop doing her homework at home because she is running out of work to do during resource class.

Absolutely ridiculous!

My child is having a great experience at Dodge. He feels comfortable and supported at school.

My child is in kinder and I'm grateful that there are 1-2 teachers/staff welcoming students in the morning and the kinder teachers walking students safely to their vehicles at pick up. This sets the stage for a welcoming and safe start to the day and safe trip home.

My child is in preschool and a lot of these questions didn't apply to me

My child is not challenged, she feels like a lot of time spent at school is wasted and teaching is subpar. I agree with her and think the bar is set way too low, for teachers and students.

My child is responsible for doing his homework on his own with the resources the school provides. I encourage him to take responsibility for himself.

My child just moved to the school she loved the commute she loves her teacher and she's seems happy when she gets home from her school day I love what bank is doing to the community and the children's lives

My child often complains about the school lunch which he won't eat

My Child's IEP is not being met in at least two areas. It is a battle to get evaluation for dyslexia despite consistent low dibbles score testing and paternal family history. Specifically, a long time teacher, Ms. Alvarez serving as 2nd grade teacher in 2023-2024 has conducted herself inappropriately, including bullying behavior towards student and parents. Acts by this teacher include reports of physical hitting and/ pushing of at least one elementary student. Mr. Gonzalez, a new hire, was observed by me raising his voice in an extremely alarming manner towards another student. The tone and volume were not appropriate/ disproportionate to the situation. Mr. Gonzalez further interfered with my parent teacher conference by talking over me and not allowing me to discuss concerns re: my child's failure in reading with his teacher. I am concerned that there is a permissive environment for adult bullies.

My child's teacher acts very much like a child herself when addressing my sons behaviors. A teacher that behaves like a child instead of an authority figure shouldn't be teaching.

My child's teacher does a good job of keeping us updated on my child's progress. The school in general could do more to share benchmark scores and what they mean, ways to support learning at home, etc.

My Daughter is only in preschool. But we love the support and community at Her school Bloom.

My daughter is still kinda new to the school Banks elementary but so far everything seems good.

My daughters English teach sent me an email regarding her personal information to he entire contact list. This is 100% unacceptable and I am more than upset over the situation.

My daughter's teacher has been great and I appreciate everything she does

My granddaughter is new to the school, so some of the questions are not available to us as of yet.

The 2 main pros that keep my daughter enrolled at Hollinger are Gate and Dual Language. I have been disappointed with music curriculum and the delay to starting orchestra, considering the school boasts about mariachi.

The administration is very communicative with emails

The front office staff is always rude. As a parent I am very involved in my kids education so it makes it hard when I don't want to deal with the office staff. It's almost impossible to speak with the principal or the assistant principal. You have to go through so many people just to be told someone will call you back. Guess what? No one ever calls back. My child has been at this school all 4 years and this is the first year I've had any of these problems. The office staff is unprofessional and speaks very rudely to me. I have a daughter who will be going into high next school year but after the way I've been treated she will not be going to Palo Verde

The lack of security staff is very concerning, there are not enough staff watching the kids in the fields and playgrounds. Staff gets defensive and rude when is questioned about the topic.

The most important thing is my son feels cared for and well educated at THMS. That is all I ask for. I love the school too.

The only issue I'm concerned with is the nurse and nursing assistant. My child has now attended for 3 years and I have heard several stories and have had a couple negative experiences. They both don't seem to take the children's health concerns/issues seriously and/or dismisses the concerns. Also, they don't call parents when needed—it seems especially the nursing assistant. I've had to get a doctors note requesting they call my child when she's having issues. I do not think this should be necessary.

the Principal needs to show more presence.

The principal sends a monthly newsletter, which is appreciated; however, I do not see any information about school site council, PTA, or other ways for parents to be involved at school. The quality of teachers at my child's school is mixed. Some of them are conscientious and strive to do a good job, for example Khylia Marshall, Jesus Escarcega, Shania Pablo, and Liz Chevalier. Some are unskilled and unmotivated--Willie Corrales--and in spite us reaching out to both the teacher and AP, they do little to improve their performance. Also, we've had teachers use AI to generate email, which might not be problematic, except that the content was completely disingenuous.

The principal is dismissive of most issues I have brought to her attention. Staff is not abominating or understanding my child's special needs.

The school closes the exit to the pick up line forcing everyone to enter and exit out of a one lane entrance which is also located directly next to where every student walks. I don't get why they do this. I've only ever seen one parent break the exit only rule. It seems so much more dangerous to make all traffic flow from the most congested road next to the school.

The school does a great job of communicating with all parents I feel like, and is more focus on the children getting the proper attention and education, I feel like they teach what is relative in school for them to learn.

The School is amazing but wish they had more programs for the k-8 kid's and more things for the middle schoolers.

The school needs to be more focused on disciplining bullies that hurt the educational environment of other students. Regardless of age.

The school needs to work better on their safety for example having the teachers walk with them as a class after school.

The school staff has been kind and helpful. Mrs. Donovan is doing an amazing job.

The school violates open meeting laws and has lost a grade level with the new principal. There are no

meeting notes or agendas posted on the website for parents or the public. We do not need videos of Trujillo on the website. We need to hear from school leadership.

The school, admin and teachers at Dodge are PHENOMENAL, the district sucks!! The district makes decisions that impact our children without consulting teachers, administrators, and the specialty teachers from the ex-Ed department. You have people that work in the district that forget what it's like to be a teacher. They look at the children as numbers and not as students. They cut funding for the students as opposed to cutting their own salaries. TUSD is one of the highest budget in the state of Arizona, but our kids suffer all because of greed in the district administration.

The staff does the best they can with the students with the resources they have.

The teachers & administrators are doing their best. I am concerned that one of my children's teachers takes over two weeks to respond to a reading intervention plan that I created. That is a long length of time, especially when the tone of the conference is that my child needs immediate intervention. I think they are underfunded, understaffed and a wasp issue that seems to not be addressed. The PTO works hard but neither the school or PTO seems to accommodate dual working parents when scheduling meetings or engagements (i.e no virtual PTC options; meetings during the work day, etc). I have submitted direct feedback on this.

While my school does do a good job communicating with families and making an attempt to make parent/teacher conferences helpful.
